

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio

May 28th. 1894

Council met in regular session with Pres Bush in the Chair and the following members present Buck Conger Harris Ray Melaney Sefert Trail Williams Wilson. Abert Corbough Davidson. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved

new Street running west from Union Ave

Wilson called attention to the necessity of some work being done on the new street running west from Union Ave to the Corporation line and the same was referred to the street committee to report at next meeting

repair Union Ave and S Arch

Attention was called to the necessity of some repairs needed on Union Ave and South Arch Street to preserve the macadam on said streets and the same was referred to the Street Committee to report estimate of cost.

Repair Trunk at Perry street

Conger reported a broken trunk or crossing at the west end of Perry Street and the Street Commissioner was instructed to repair the same at once.

Street Commissioner to report bad crossings

On motion of Ray the Street Commissioner was instructed to investigate the condition of the street crossings in the city and report those needing repairs and the location of the same.

repair west main street

Buck reported that on west Main Street in front of Fred Maus property there was no out let for the water accumulating at that point and the same was referred to the Street Committee.

Scrape Lincoln Avenue

On motion of Harris the Street Commissioner was instructed to scrape Lincoln Avenue from Ely Street to the Cemetery

Report of Sewer Committee on south Arch

Sefert of the Sewer Committee to whom had been referred the condition of Arch street near Cambridge reported that the most practical way to fix the same would be to build two Catch Basins

" at that point and also raise the brick pavement. and that the same could be done for \$2500 and moved that if it could be done for that amount that the same be done under the supervision of the engineer. seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 10 nays 0 and the motion was declared carried.

to nuisance
South Liberty

President Bush called attention to a nuisance existing on South Liberty street south of Summit Street caused by the drain across Liberty being higher than the surface of the ground on the west side of the street and reported that it would be necessary to do some filling to relieve the difficulty and Wilson moved the matter be referred to the sewer committee with power to act. the cost of the same if done not to exceed \$3000 seconded by Williams and Carried yeas 10 nays none

petition for
Hudson to lay
sidewalk

A petition signed by a number of ladies in the vicinity of Grant and Arch Streets asking council to take some action to compel R.E. Hudson to construct a sidewalk along the north side of the lot at the south east corner of Grant and Arch streets was referred to the sidewalk committee to report at next meeting

petition for
street crossing

A Petition for a street crossing at the corner of Linden Ave and Grant Street was referred to the street committee.

report of
water committee

Conger of the water committee reported that the committee had investigated the petitions referred to them relative to the extension of water mains in different parts of the city and that they recommended that the mains be extended to furnish fire protection to a portion of the first ward lying north of Ely street and also in the third ward to protect that part of the city lying south and east of the steel works. a communication from S Johnson superintendent of the water works company was submitted as follows. "To the Council Alliance Ohio, in East

The Council conclude to order any Hydrants this season. The Water Works Co agree to wait for water rental for said Hydrants for one year from the time said Hydrants are placed. Then to be paid for the past year." signed D Johnson Sept.

Resolution to
Extend Water
Mains

Conger then offered the following resolution and moved its adoption " Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that the City Clerk be and is hereby instructed to issue an order to the Alliance Water Works Co to extend the water pipes on Broadway East to Willow Street and South on Willow Street to Summit Street also to extend the pipe on Union Avenue from City Street ^{North} to Wayne Street" Williams seconded the motion to adopt. and Kay moved to amend by including in said order the main or pipe petitioned for for South Freedom Street. seconded by Conger and Carried. The Yeas and Nays were then called on the adoption of the resolution as amended resulting. Yeas Duck Conger Harris Kay Melany Seft Trail Williams Wilson Bush. Yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Stand Pipe

Wilson reported that the stand pipe for the water works was being overflowed at times to the detriment of surrounding property and the water committee was instructed to notify the Company of the fact

referred to the

Solicitor Coaine asked Council for instructions relative to the injunction granted by the courts restraining the selling of the fire engine and other city property to satisfy the Judgment in favor of J. L. Clippinger and asked whether it was the wish of Council that he should proceed with the case or have the same dissolved and the matter was referred to the Judiciary Committee with power to act.

The Judiciary Committee to whom was referred the petition for the improvement of

reported that they had examined the valuations of the different lots along the line of the proposed improvement and found that all property would bear the assessment estimating the same at \$2.50 per foot front. except one which would not pay the full amount by \$18⁰⁰ and on motion of Wilson the report was accepted.

A resolution declaring it necessary to construct a lateral sewer in Market Street from Arch Street to Union Avenue joining portions of sewers no 16 and 22 was read and Harris moved the adoption of the same seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Conger Buck Harris Key Melaney Defert Trail ~~Wilson~~ Williams Wilson Bush. Yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

On Motion of Buck the matter of determining the cost of placing the ^{to Carr's Coal bank} alley in passable condition was referred to the Street Committee.

An Ordinance to establish a grade on Warehouse street was read first time and Wilson moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Buck the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas. Buck Conger Harris Key Melaney Defert Trail Wilson Williams Bush yeas 10 nays none. The ordinance was read second time and Conger moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read third time seconded by Key and carried. Yeas 10 nays none. The Ordinance was read third time and Buck moved the same be placed on its final passage seconded by Defert. the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Harris Key Melaney Defert Trail Williams Wilson Bush. Yeas 10 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

No further business Council adjourned
