

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio

June 11th 1894

Council met in regular session Pres
Bush in the chair and the following
members present. Conger Crumbough Davidson
Harris Kay Melaney Trail. Absent Buck
Sefert Williams Wilson.

On motion of Davidson the reading of
the minutes was dispensed with

The Sewer Committee
submitted the following report. "In the

report of Sewer undersigned members of the Sewer Committee
Committee on to whom was referred the bids for Sewers no
bids 10-11 & 12. would respectfully recommend that
the bid of Berger & Macauley be accepted for
Sewer no 10. and the bid of Henry W. Anson
be accepted for Sewer no 12 and that all
bids for Sewer no 11 be rejected and that
the City Clerk be instructed to re-advertise
for the Construction of Sewer no 11 from Main
Sewer no 2 West to Union Avenue

Davidson moved the report be adopted
seconded by Kay the yeas and nays were
called resulting yeas Crumbough Davidson
Harris Kay Melaney Trail Bush. yeas 7 nays 0
and the report was declared adopted

President Bush called attention
of Council to the fact that it would be
difficult to build ^{the East Part of} Sewer no 12. unless
that part of no 11. lying between Main Sewer
no 2 and the first alley west being about 80 feet
and also in the alley running from Sewer
no 11 south to Ash Street to connect with
no 12. was built first so as to provide an
outlet for water that would likely be
encountered in no 12. and that it would
be necessary to construct that part of
the sewer before commencing no 12. and
on motion of Harris seconded by Trail
the matter of connecting Main Sewer no 2 with
Sewer no 12 was referred to the Sewer Committee
to report at next meeting

Report to ad
for bids for
no 11

Harris moved that the Clerk be instructed to advertise for bids for the construction of ^{that part of} lateral Sewer no 11. lying between the first alley west of Main Sewer no 2 and Union Avenue. seconded by Trail. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas. Conger Combs Davidon Harris Kay Melaney Trail Bush. yeas 8 nays none and the motion was declared carried

Location
of Sewers printed

On motion of Harris seconded by Davidon the Clerk was instructed to have printed a description of the lateral sewers of the city giving the numbers and location of the same.

Report on
Hersey's Contract

The following communication and report was submitted. "To the Council Alliance His Gentlemen. I herewith report final completions and estimate for main sewers no 2 & 3 as constructed by Messrs L. C. & H. D. Hersey the final estimate showing a deduction of 25 00 for estimated cost of rebuilding the manhole on east side sewer at the south line of Keystone Street the same not having been built in a workmanlike manner and the contractors having neglected or refused to construct the same in violation of the terms of their contract. and to close the matter up recommend the rebuilding of said manhole by the city making payment of the expense out of the above named reserved sum and with the exception of the above named manhole recommend the acceptance of the above work"

signed L. C. Chapin Consulting Engineer.
To which was added. "We the undersigned members of the sewer committee recommend the acceptance of the above report" signed Jno Safut. L. C. Davidon.

Harris moved the adoption of the above report seconded by Trail and carried yeas Conger Combs Davidon Harris Kay Melaney Trail Bush. yeas 7 nays none
A contract with Bergner and Mearns for the construction

seconded by Conger the engineer was
instructed to set the stakes for said work

to Broadway nos read and Conger moved
the same be adopted seconded by Trail. The
Yans and maps were called resulting Yans
Conger Davidson Harris Kay McLaney Trail
maps Crubugh and Bush and the motion to
adopt was declared lost.

A resolution requiring Isabella
Oster the owner of the west half of lot no 564
to construct a sidewalk in front of said lot
was read and Conger moved the adoption of
the same seconded by Trail. The yans and maps
were called resulting Yans Conger Crubugh
Davidson Harris Kay McLaney Trail Bush
Yans & maps none and the resolution was
declared adopted.
