Council met in regular session with President Bush in the chair and the following members present:

Buck Davidson Kay Melaney Sefert Trail Wilson. Absent Conyer Crubrough Harris. Williams. Minutes of June 4<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> read and approved

Tax levy  
for 1894

The finance Committee reported having made the tax levy for the year 1894 of nine mills as follows.  
for the General fund .3 mills Street fund 1.0 mill  
Light fund 1.3 mills fire .8 mills Sinking fund  
1.7 mills Water fund 1.9 mills Police & Salary fund  
2 mills Sanitary fund .2 mills Street improvement  
fund 1.0 mill Sewer fund .6 mills. on  
motion of Wilson seconded by Trail the  
report was adopted. An Ordinance providing  
for the above levy was then read and Wilson  
moved the same be placed on its passage  
seconded by Davidson. The yeas and nays  
were called resulting yeas Buck Davidson  
Kay Melaney Sefert Trail Wilson Bush,  
Yeas 7 nays none and the ordinance was  
declared passed.

An Ordinance to levy a special  
tax of one mill on all the taxable property of  
the city except the 6<sup>th</sup> ward. as authorized by  
a special act of the legislature was read and  
Buck moved the same be placed on its  
passage. seconded by Wilson the yeas and  
nays were called resulting yeas Buck  
Davidson Kay Melaney Sefert Trail  
Williams Bush. Yeas 7 nays none and  
the ordinance was declared passed.

remove telephone  
poles

Buck reported that telephone  
poles along Miller Street were located on the  
sidewalk at certain places and moved that  
the telephone Company be notified to remove  
the same seconded by Wilson and  
carried

Proposition of  
Anson to build  
sewers

A Communication from Henry Anson containing a proposition to the City to build that part of sewer no 11 from Main sewer no 2. west to the first alley and in said alley south to Ash Street to connect with sewer no 12 for the sum of Two Hundred and seventy five dollars. was submitted and Davidson moved the same be accepted and that the Clerk send Mr Anson Contract and bond for same. seconded by Trail and Carried Yeas Buck Davidson Kay Melaney Sefert Trail Bush. Yeas 8 nays none

Clerk to make

Davidson moved that the Clerk be instructed to send Contract and bond to Mr Anson for construction of sewer no 12. to have signed. (The Clerk having previously read a communication from Mr Anson asking that the same be done) seconded by Trail and Carried Yeas Buck Davidson Kay Melaney Sefert Trail Bush. Yeas 8 nays none.

Petition to  
open West Grant  
Street

A Petition signed by Emery Miller. G. M. Henry. Jno Y. Williams and A. S. Springer asking that West Grant Street be extended west to a point in line with the second street west of and parallel with Union Avenue also a communication signed by G. M. Henry Jno Y. Williams and Emery Miller agreeing to donate the land necessary for such extension where the street passed through lands owned by them was submitted and referred to the platting Committee to report at next meeting

Rosenberry  
Street Sewer

Buck reported the necessity of doing something with the sewer on Rosenberry Street and the same was referred to the Sewer Committee to report at next meeting.

Water mains  
in 6<sup>th</sup> ward

Wilson called attention to the matter of having the water Main extended on South Arch Street from College Street to State and west on State Street to connect with the main now laid, and reported that the residents of that portion of the city were very anxious to have such extension made, and the same was referred to the Water Committee to report at next meeting.

report of Chief  
of fire Dept

The report of the Chief of the fire department for the year ending May 23 1894 was read and on motion of Wilson seconded by Buck the same was received and ordered placed on file.

Plans and  
specifications for  
Market st

The engineer submitted plans and specifications for the improvement of Market Street from Arch Street to Union Avenue also an estimate of the cost the same being \$290 per foot front. Wilson moved the <sup>plans and</sup> specifications be adopted seconded by Defert The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Davidson Kay Melaney Defert Trail Wilson Bush Yeas 7 nays none and the motion was declared carried.
