The following resolution was read
Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Stark County Ohio that it is deemed necessary by and is hereby declared the intent of this Council to appropriate to the use of said City the following described property viz: Situated in the City of Alliance County of Stark and State of Ohio a triangular piece of land bounded on the south by Main Street, on the west by Liberty Street and on the north and east by the Pittsburgh St Wayne and Chicago Railway Company's right of way and commonly known as the Kayler property, for the purpose of building a bridge over the Pennsylvania Company's tracks provided for by resolution passed by this Council on the 24th day of April 1894 commencing at Liberty Street at the north side of Main Street thence Eastward over said Kayler property thence northward over the said Penna Company's tracks and to Patterson Street. The City Solicitor upon the passage of this resolution is hereby instructed to commence the proper proceedings in Court for an inquiry and assessment of damages for said appropriation the payment of which together with the costs shall be paid out of the street improvement fund.

Proposed Change of Plan of Sewer no 11
 A communication from L. C. Chapin relative to the changing of the plans for sewer no 11, was submitted as follows: To the honorable city Council Gentlemen. I have carefully investigated the question of the removal of that portion of sewer no 11 lying in Main Street between Union Avenue and Mechanic Street and after due consideration on account of the necessary removal of the pavement in Main Street for the construction of sewer no 11 and also for the construction of the many house connections which will be necessary to reach from the sewer to the curb lines deem it advisable to make the following changes in the sewer plan as outlined on your maps: - 1st. to omit the portion of sewer no 11 in main street between Union Avenue and Mechanic Street making provision to carry sewer no 11

11 From the intersection of Main Street and Union Avenue northwardly along Union Avenue to Sewer no 9 at Prospect Street enlarging sewer no 9 to accommodate the increased flow
 2nd To acquire the right of way through the properties between Main Street and Prospect Street from Park Street westwardly to a point in the Lot now owned by W W Gilson and to Construct a six inch lateral sewer from the above named lot eastwardly through the right of way to be so acquired and also through the alleys between Main and Prospect Streets to Main Sewer no 3 in Mechanic Street. 3^d - To Extend Sewer no 16 in Union Avenue northwardly to the first alley south of Main Street thence eastwardly in and along said alley to Main sewer no 3 in Mechanic Street. 4th - To remove lateral sewer no 25 from Columbia Street into the Alley north of Columbia Street. 5th to remove lateral sewer no 26 from Broadway into Alley lying north of Broadway. Should these recommendations be adopted I will have the necessary changes made on the general map and plans
