Council met in regular session with Pres

Wilson reported that Simpson
Street west of Arch was in a condition that
needed attention by having a culvert built
across it and moved that the street committee
be instructed to have 60 feet of tile placed
so as to make the street passable. seconded
by Buck the yeas and nays were called
resulting yeas Buck Davidson Defert Trail
Wilson Nays Conger Kay Harris Melaney
Williams Bush. Yeas 5 nays 6 and the
motion was declared lost

line road

Bush reported that some work
was necessary on the County line road south
from Broadway and an motion of Harris
seconded by Conger the matter was referred
to the street committee to investigate and
report at next meeting.

relative to the proposed change in the place
of lateral sewers between Mechanic Street
and Union Avenue in the vicinity of Marie
Street and which had been tabled July 16th
was taken up and Davidson moved that

seconded by Buck. Harris moved that
the matter lay on the table for one
week and the engineer prepare an outline
of the plan and that the Sewer Committee
secure the right of way necessary for such
change and have the same in writing

The Judiciary Committee to whom had been referred the Claim of Israel Cook for damages claimed on account of filling of Lincoln Avenue reported as follows: "The undersigned committee to whom was referred the matter of compensating Israel Cook for alleged damages arising by reason of the construction of an embankment near his premises beg leave to report 1st That we think the amount claimed by Mr Cook is excessive even if the City were liable.

2nd That from such information as we can obtain we are not of the opinion that the City is liable for the injury complained of and therefore advise that for the present at least no payment for the same be made" signed

Report on removal of Band Stand

The committee on buildings and grounds made the following report: "The Joint Committee to whom was referred the matter of the removal of the band stand from the public square beg leave to report that owing to the persistent opposition on the part of many citizens we beg to report adversely on such removal at present. We would also recommend that additional hitching rails be provided along the west and south sides of the Public square." signed

B. C. Davidson, Theo Wilson, Committee on bldgs and grounds. Buck moved the adoption of the above report seconded by Harris. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Davidson Harris Wilson Nays Conger Kay Melaney Defert Trail Williams Bush. Yeas 4 nays 7. and the motion was declared lost.

Adoption of resolution to remove Band stand

Conger moved that the resolution instructing the street Commissioner to remove the Band stand from the Public Square which was laid on the table July 16" be taken from the table seconded by Kay and carried.

The yeas and nays were then called on the adoption of the resolution resulting yeas Conger Kay Melaney Defert Trail Williams Bush. Nays Buck Davidson Harris Wilson Yeas 7 nays 4. and the resolution was declared adopted.
