Council met in regular session with President Bush presiding and the following members present. - Conger Davidson Harris Kay Trail Williams. Absent Buck Embaugh Melaney Sept Bridson

Resolution to add  
more men to  
fire dept

The following resolution was offered. "Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance that there be employed in addition to the force now employed in the fire Department, three more men at a total cost not to exceed \$25<sup>00</sup> per month, the said three men to be on duty every night and to be ready to respond to all calls in daytime and to be under the control of the Chief of the fire department, and in case any said men fail to attend any fire and it is necessary to fill their places the same shall be done at the expense of the fire department and without cost to the City." Williams moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Conger. Harris moved to amend by referring to the fire Committee to report at next meeting. seconded by Davidson and carried.

Repair street  
crossing on  
Columbia street

Kay reported street crossing on the south side of Columbia Street at the first alley east of Arch street to be in bad condition and the same was referred to the Street Committee to report at next meeting.

Set grade stakes  
on Market st

On Motion of Harris seconded by Trail the engineer was instructed to set grade stakes on Market street for the proposed improvement.

Grade at Corner  
of Freedom  
and Grant streets

Kay called attention to the condition of the grade at the corner of Freedom and Grant streets stating that certain property owners had excavated for sidewalks. the grade of which was considerably below the surface of the

Street and moved that the matter be referred to the Street Committee to report an estimate of the cost of putting the streets at that point to grade. Seconded by Truitt and Carried

Market street

Davidson moved that there be a Committee of three appointed to investigate and recommend the kind of Material to be used in the improvement of Market Street between Arch and Union Avenue. seconded by Conyer Harris moved to amend by instructing the Permanent improvement Committee to ascertain the kind of material the Contractors intend using and report same to Council. the same instructions to apply to College Street. seconded by Conyer. and on motion of Key seconded by Truitt the whole matter was laid on the table. and Council adjourned
