

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio Sept 24th 1894

Council Met in regular session with President Bush presiding and the following members present. Senger Davidson Harris Kay Trail Williams Buck. Absent Cruberga Sefert McLaney Wilson. Minutes of Sept 17th and 19th read and approved

College street
sidewalk

A petition from property owners on College Street between Arch street and Union Avenue asking that Council fix the line for sidewalks on said street one foot from the lot line was referred to the sidewalk committee.

College street
sidewalk north
side

A Petition from property owners on the north side of College Street between Arch street and Union Avenue asking that provision be made for the sidewalk when constructed on the north side of said street between the points mentioned be laid out to the curb line was referred to the sidewalk committee

remonstrance
against sewer 17

A remonstrance signed by property owners along the line of lateral sewer no 17 protesting against building said sewer was referred to the sewer committee

Citizens Committee
on Market Street

A Petition signed by property owners on Market Street between Arch street and Union Avenue asking that J. L. Craven and Wm Chambers be appointed as Citizens Committee to oversee the improvement of said Street was presented and Harris moved the said J. L. Craven and Wm Chambers be appointed as said Citizens Committee seconded by Kay and Carried

Sewer pipe

A communication from B. F. Sullivan representing the State line Sewer pipe Company making a proposition to sell to the City the sewer pipe along the line of no 4 sewer at the same price at which Messrs Berger and Massey will to pay for them was referred to the sewer committee

Proposition of
Anson to build
sewer

Mr Henry Anson submitted the following proposition. To the Council of the City of Alliance I will build sewer on Market street from Manhole in Mechanic Street to alley east of Mechanic Street for sum of 78 cents per foot City to furnish iron pipe and material for going through Mechanic Street Culvert. Said pipe to be 8 inches in diameter I will also build 12 inch sewer across Market street. (said sewer being a continuation of Mechanic Street sewer) 30 feet more or less for sum of 90 cents per foot. If required will build manhole on sewer on Market Street for sum of \$3.50 City to furnish water for flushing sewer

Davidson moved the proposition be accepted seconded by Trail. Conger moved be laid on the table until next meeting seconded by Kay and carried.

Resolution to
Change date of
Bonds

The following resolution was offered. - Whereas it seems desirable for the best interests of the City of Alliance that the date of issue and date of maturity of the \$21,000 refunding bonds issued under Ordinance passed August 13th 1894 be changed from September 29th 1894 to October 1st 1894 Therefore Be it resolved that the date of said \$21,000 of bonds be altered from Sept 29th 1894 to October 1st 1894 and that the date of maturity of said bonds be altered from September 29th 1904 to October 1st 1904.

Kay moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Bucke Conger Davidson Harris Kay Trail Williams Bucke. Yeas 8 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted

Baker to prepare
Plans for bridge

Harris moved that Mr C. B. Baker be instructed to prepare plans and specifications for the approaches to the proposed bridge over the P. & W. & C. & O. R. Tracks seconded by Davidson and carried

Williams, Teeters
and Culp to connect
with sewer

Harris offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: "Resolved that A. J. Williams, R. H. Teeters and J. B. Culp be permitted to connect their house sewers with the sanitary sewer in the Alley ~~South~~ of Main Street that being the nearest sanitary sewer to their premises." Buck seconded the motion to adopt, the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conger Davidson Harris Kay Trail Williams Bush. Yeas 8 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

To suspend work
on sewer 27

Davidson reported that great difficulty had been encountered on sewer no 27 on account of water and that it would be almost impossible to build said sewer until sewer no 4 was built so as to provide an outlet. and moved that the work be suspended until such time as Council may order it to be proceeded with. seconded by Trail and carried.

To extend water
Main on State
Street

Conger offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: "Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, That the water works Company be ordered to extend the water main on east State Street from the present terminus of the main, east 8 1/2 feet and place two hydrants on said extension on condition that the bill for hydrant rental shall not be presented for one year." Trail seconded the motion to adopt, the yeas and nays were called resulting: Yeas Buck, Conger, Davidson, Harris, Kay, Trail, Williams, Bush; Yeas 8 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Conger offered the following and moved its adoption. Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that the water works Company be ordered to extend the water main on west Main Street

from the present terminus of the main west 406
feet and place one hydrant on said extension, on
Condition that the bill for hydrant rental shall not
not be presented for one year." Williams seconded
the motion to adopt, the yeas and nays were called
resulting yeas Buck Conger Davidson Harris
Kay Trail Williams Bush. Yeas 8 nays none and
the resolution was declared adopted.

To employ
more men for
fire dept

The fire committee made the
following report: "We the fire committee to whom
was referred the resolution providing for the
employment of three more men for the fire Dept
beg leave to report in favor of the adoption of the
same." Signed J.R. Williams. Chas G. Kay
Davidson moved the adoption of the report seconded
by Conger. Harris moved to amend the resolution
by having the resolution provide that the additional
men be approved by the fire committee and
that they be placed on the pay roll and be
paid direct by the city. seconded by Trail and
Carried. On motion of Williams seconded by
Trail the resolution was taken from the table.

The resolution as amended was then read as
follows: "Be it resolved by the Council of the City
of Alliance Ohio that there be employed in
addition to the force now employed in the fire
department three more men at a total cost
of \$25⁰⁰ per month, the said three men
to be on duty every night, and be ready
to respond to all calls in daytime and be under
the control of the chief of the fire department,
and in case any of said men shall fail to
attend any fire, and it is necessary to fill
their places the same shall be done at the
expense of the fire department and without
cost to the city. said men to be approved by
the fire committee. and placed on the pay
roll and be paid direct by the city."

The yeas and nays were called ^{of the yeas} on the adoption,
resulting. Yeas Buck Conger Davidson Harris Kay
Trail Williams Bush. and the resolution was declared adopted.

Sidewalk
resolution

A resolution requiring M. J. Webb, the owner of Out lot no 137, ^{to construct a sidewalk} was read and Conger moved its adoption seconded by Trail and Carried Yeas 8 nays none.

A resolution requiring N. W. Johnson the owner of lot no 944 to construct a sidewalk in front of said lot was read and Conger moved its adoption seconded by Trail and Carried Yeas 8 nays none.

Set Grade Stakes

On motion of Davidson seconded by Williams the Engineer was instructed to set grade stakes for a sidewalk for F. C. Hartzell on north Union Avenue.

Repair walk
on N Park st

Davidson reported that the sidewalk over the stream on North Park Street was in bad condition and the Clerk was instructed to notify the owner of the abutting lot to repair the same.

Repair walk
on N Webb st

Trail called attention to the condition of the sidewalk on the East side of South Webb Street over the run and on motion of Conger it was agreed that Council meet at that point on Tuesday the 25th and inspect the same.

Harris moved that the Clerk notify all Contractors doing work for the City to use more care about leaving the streets obstructed seconded by Conger. Buck moved to amend by having the instructions given the inspectors. seconded by Davidson and carried.

The Solicitor reported that the case of Mary B Coates against the City in the Common Pleas Court was arraigned for trial on Thursday the 27th and stated that it would be necessary for Council to appropriate some funds to defray the expenses of the trial and May moved that the Clerk be instructed to draw a warrant in favor

Miller Case Harris reported that it would be

 and moved that the Committee in charge of
 said case and the solicitor be authorized to
 expend \$10.00 for that purpose seconded by Kay
 and carried Yeas & nays none.

A resolution to accept bid of and contract with

 of Market Street. Be it resolved by the Council of the
 City of Alliance Ohio that the bid of Wm McCallum and Thos

 to Union Avenue be accepted the same being the lowest in
 the aggregate for said work and that the Mayor and Clerk
 be authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the city
 with the Wm McCallum and Thomas McCallum with F J Poto
 and James McCallum as sureties for doing said work at
 the following prices to wit:
