

Albion Ohio Oct 1st 1894

Council met in regular session with Vice President Conyer in the chair and the following members present Buck Davidson Harris Kay Sefert Trail Wilson. absent Leubaugh Melany Williams Bush.

Mayor's report

The Mayor's report for the month of Sept - showing fines and licenses collected to the amount of \$136⁵⁰ was presented and on motion of Wilson accepted.

report of Sewer Permits

The Engineer submitted report of sewer permits granted during September, the number being twenty one the report being accompanied by a check for ~~twenty~~ one dollars and on motion of Davidson report accepted.

Petition relative to Columbia st sewer

A Petition signed by G A Hess J S Cassaday and R Varner asking that their names be cancelled from a former petition relative to changing the line of sewer on Columbia street and asking that the sewer be built in Columbia Street was referred to the Sewer Committee.

Petition to change grade on Market street

A Petition signed by property owners on Market Street asking that the grade be changed at the intersection of Market and Park Streets by lowering the same twelve inches at ~~the intersection~~ of that point was on motion of Harris referred to the Grade Committee with power to act.

Payment of bills

Ray of the finance Committee reported the committee having approved a number of bills, and presented the bill of Geo E Waring of \$159⁰⁰ for sewer plans which bill Mr Waring claimed the city owed him under an old contract. Davidson moved the bill be allowed and paid seconded by Kay the Yeas and were called resulting Yeas Buck Conyer Davidson Harris Kay Sefert Trail Ray Wilson. Yeas ^{one} ~~two~~ and the motion was declared carried. The bills as approved were then read and

Key moved they be allowed as read ^{and} that an Ordinance be prepared providing for their payment seconded by Trail and carried. The Ordinance being prepared was read and Key moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Harris and carried Yeas Buck Conger Davidson Harris Key Siefert Trail Wilson Yeas 8 nays none.

Engineer to issue no more permits for Sewerage

It being reported to Council that a case was pending in the Common Pleas Court in which the Court was asked to restrain the City from allowing the sanitary sewers to discharge into the Mohoning river at the present outlet. Harris offered the following resolution and moved its adoption "Resolved that the engineer be instructed to issue no permits to tap any of the main or lateral sewers belonging to the sanitary sewerage system until further ordered by Council" Davidson seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conger Davidson Harris Key Siefert Trail Wilson Yeas 8 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Report of Sewer Committee on purchase of pipe

Davidson of the sewer committee to whom had been referred the proposition of the State Line sewer pipe Co to sell to the City the pipe rejected on sewer no 4 reported that the committee was not in favor of buying the pipe. Wilson moved the report be accepted seconded by Trail and carried.

Free Fair

J. L. Gold president of the Free Fair association asked Council for the privileges of the public square and city lot for the use of the association they to have the ~~discretion~~ ^{discretion} of licenses. Wilson moved the same be granted seconded by Trail On motion of Buck the motion was amended to require the association to pay for all extra policemen necessary and to clean up the streets after the fair leaving them in as good condition as before. The motion as amended was then ~~put~~ and lost.

to Craven's Scales A petition from property owners on Market street asking that J. C. Craven be required to remove his scales from the street was presented and Buck moved that the request of the petitioners be granted seconded by Davidson. Davidson then moved to lay the petition on the table until next meeting seconded by Trail and Carried. Trail moved that the street Commissioner be instructed to tear up the walk on the east side of Webb Street over the run and to barricade the same so that no person would get in. seconded by Wilson and Carried.

Plans Harris moved that the engineer prepare plans and an estimate of the cost of fixing said sidewalk. seconded by Davidson and Carried.
- Repair Lockup and grounds Committee be instructed to have the necessary repairs made to the city prison seconded by Seft and Carried Yeas 5 nays none.
- Prepare Grade
for Freedom st Kay moved that the engineer be instructed to prepare an amended grade Ordinance for south Freedom street seconded by Harris and Carried Yeas 5 nays none.
- Accept work
of Auld Seft moved that the work of Robert Auld for grading Linden Avenue and High Street be accepted on condition that he remove a large stone that still remains in the street. seconded by Davidson and Carried Yeas 5 nays none.
- Extend Sewer
across Market st. Harris moved that the sewer Committee be instructed to have the Machine Street sewer extended across Market street. seconded by Buck and Carried Yeas 5 nays none.
- set Stakes On Motion of Harris the Engineer was instructed to set stakes for sidewalk for West Culpa. on motion Council adjourned
