

Alliance O. Oct 5 1894

Council met in special session in response to the following call. "You are hereby notified that a special meeting of the Alliance City Council is called to meet on Friday Evening Oct 5" 1894 at 7 o'clock P.M. to take action relative to changing the grade on Market street and to consider the case of Wirich against the city" Signed Jno Seft Trail O.C. Conger. With Vice President Conger in the Chair and the following members present. Buck Bush Crumbagh. Davidson Harris Kay Seft Trail. The Clerk being absent C.C. Davidson was Chosen Clerk Pro Tem.

An Ordinance to amend the grade on Market Street was read first time and Amund Grade Harris moved the rules be suspended and the on Market st ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Kay the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush Crumbagh Davidson Harris Kay Seft Trail Conger. The rules were declared suspended. The Ordinance was read second time by title and Harris moved the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read third time by title seconded by Buck the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush Crumbagh Davidson Harris Kay Seft Trail Conger. Yeas 9 nays none. The rules were declared suspended. The Ordinance was read third time by title and Harris moved the same be placed on its final passage seconded by Buck. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush Crumbagh Davidson Harris Kay Seft Trail Conger. Yeas 9 nays none and The Ordinance was declared passed.

Height of overhead bridges
Bush moved that contractors be notified to conform to the state law relative to the height of bridges over Railroad tracks.

Settlement of
Weirich Case

Buck moved that the case of Weirich against the city be settled on the verdict of the Common Pleas Court recorded by Trail. Harris moved to amend by having the case dismissed and the city pay the verdict on condition that Weirich pay his own costs. amendment accepted and motion as amended carried.

On Motion of Buck seconded by Harris the clerk was instructed to notify Attorney A. B. Strong of the action of Council in the above case.
