

Council Chamber Seance Ohio Oct 15. 1894

Council met in regular session with Vice President Conger presiding and members all present. Minutes of meetings of Oct 1st and 5th read and approved.

W W Webb to remove buildings

Melaney reported that certain out buildings belonging to W. W. Webb were occupying a part of the alley in the rear of his property at the corner of Main and Arch Streets and moved that the Marshal be instructed to notify Mr Webb to remove them at once and if not done then the Marshal to remove them at Webb's expense seconded by Defert and carried

Oxford St Grade ordinance

An Ordinance to amend the grade on Oxford Street was read first time and Buck moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Harris. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Crumbugh Davidson Harris Kay Defert Melaney Trail Williams Wilson Conger Yeas 12 nays none, The rules were declared suspended the Ordinance was read second time by title and Buck moved the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read third time by title seconded by Williams and carried Yeas 12 nays none. The ordinance was read third time by title and Buck moved the final passage of the same. seconded by Davidson The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Crumbugh Davidson Harris Kay Melaney Defert Trail Williams Wilson Conger Yeas 12 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Freedom street Grade ordinance

An Ordinance to amend the Grade on South Freedom Avenue was read first time and Buck moved the rules be suspended and the Ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Trail The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Crumbugh Davidson Harris Kay Melaney Defert Trail Williams Wilson Conger Yeas 12 nays none

The rules were declared suspended The Ordinance was read second time by title and Buck moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read third time by title. seconded by Wilson and carried. Yeas 12 nays none

The Ordinance was read third time by title At this time a petition was presented signed by property owners on Freedom Street south of Broadway asking that the grade be lowered from Columbia Street to Market Street and leaving the grade on Broadway as now established ~~and the same was referred to the grade committee~~ The different members of the grade committee expressed themselves as being in favor of the grade as provided for in the ordinance just read. and Kay moved the same be placed on its final passage seconded by Buck the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Cambrough Davidson Harris Kay Melaney Sefert Trail Williams Wilson Conger. Yeas 12 nays none

Cemetery Trustees

The report of the Secretary and Treasurer of the Cemetery Trustees was submitted showing cash in hands of Treasurer \$1410.67 and secretary \$93.20 and on motion of Davidson seconded by Trail the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Craver's Scales

Attorney W. M. Rouch at this time addressed Council and stated that he wished to call their attention to a nuisance on Market Street consisting of a pair of weighing scales in front of J. C. Craver's warehouse and a sidetrack crossing Market Street at Mechanic Street and asked Council to take the necessary action to have them removed. A petition was then presented asking that the scales be allowed to remain. A petition having been presented on Oct 1st asking for the removal of the scales and laid on the table. Kay moved the same be taken from the table seconded by Trail and carried. There being a motion to grant the request of the petitioners at the time the petition was tabled, the yeas and nays were called on the motion resulting yeas

Wilson offered the following

True Fair

Resolved that permission be given the free fair
 association to hold a street fair in Alliance
 this fall and for that purpose to use the public
 square, the public grounds around the city
 building and the streets and alleys adjacent
 thereto with the understanding and agreement
 that the association is to pay for all extra
 police force that may be required by reason
 of this fair and to clean up after the fair
 the streets alleys and public grounds and
 put them in as good condition as they now are
 Trail seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas
 and nays were called resulting yeas Buck
 Bush Combaugh Harris Kay Melaney Sefert
 Trail Williams Wilson Nays Conyer Davidson
 Yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was
 declared adopted.

Kay offered the following resolution
 and moved its adoption: Be it resolved by the
 Council of the City of Alliance that Consulting Engineer
 Chapin be and is hereby authorized and directed
 to prepare a plan of the outlet of the main
 sanitary sewer showing its connection as at
 present made with the Mahoning River and
 its proposed extension as shown on the general
 plan of Sewerage adopted by the City Council
 and that the said engineer be authorized to
 present such plan to the state board of
 health for their consideration and to make
 such explanations and statements to
 said board as may be required to place
 the matter fully before them for their
 consideration" Buck seconded the
 motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were
 called resulting yeas 12 nays none and
 the resolution was declared adopted

Tile drain on
Market st

Harris called attention to a tile drain on ^{South side of} Market Street between Arch and Mechanic which had been put in some time ago and raised the question as to whether this drain might not be used in place of the one provided for in the specifications for the improvement of said market street, and moved the matter be referred to the Committee in Charge of the improvement and Engineer with power to determine. seconded by Kay and carried.
