

Council Chamber Alliance O. Oct 22. 1894

Council met in adjourned session with Vice President Conger presiding and the following members present, Buck Crumbach Davidson Harris Kay Melaney Trail Williams. Absent Bush Defert and Wilson.

A bill of Middleton & Berlin for \$570⁰⁰ as the first estimate for the College Street improvement and a bill of O. M. Coxen for \$286⁴³ for costs in the case of the city against Lacy were presented and Kay moved the bills be allowed and that the clerk prepare an ordinance providing for their payment seconded by Trail and carried. The ordinance being prepared was read and Kay moved the same be passed seconded by Harris. The Yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Crumbach Davidson Harris Kay Melaney Trail Williams Conger Yeas 9 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

The clerk reported that of the \$50⁰⁰ placed in his hands to defray expenses of the Kayler case he had expended \$39⁵⁰ and of the \$50⁰⁰ for the Coates case he had expended \$23⁵⁰ leaving a balance in his hands of \$37⁰⁰. and also reported that the case of Hartzell against the City was assigned for trial on the 23^d and asked whether he should use the balance in his hands for the purpose of defraying expenses in said case.

Harris stated that inasmuch as there would be quite a number of witnesses required in the case it might require more money to meet the expense and moved that in addition to the \$37⁰⁰ in the hands of the clerk there be \$50⁰⁰ more appropriated and placed in the hands of the clerk to be used in the case seconded by Williams and carried Yeas 9 nays none

Melaney reported that the bridge across the stream in the alley south of North Freedom Street and near the Scanlon property was in bad condition and needed repairing and Harris moved that the same be referred to the street committee with power to act seconded by Davidson and carried Yeas 9 nays none.

Buck reported some repairs needed at the culvert on South Liberty Street and moved that the street commissioner be instructed to do the same. seconded by Trail and carried Yeas 9 nays none.

report of Engineer
on Webb st
Culvert

The engineer submitted an estimate of the cost of replacing the stone Culvert on North Webb Street with tile and covering the same with dirt at \$300⁰⁰ and Harris moved that the matter be referred to the permanent improvement Committee ^{and engineer} with power to act on condition that the expense shall not exceed the amount that can be realized from the sale of the stone now in the Culvert seconded by Davidson the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Crubaugh Davidson Harris Kay Melaney ~~Trail~~ Williams Conyer Yeas 9 nays none

Harris offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:
Resolved that the Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City with C. M. Carley for furnishing gravel on Colleys Street in accordance with his bid for said work viz "48^c per cubic yard" after the clerk certifies that the money required for the above mentioned contract was in the treasury and not appropriated for any other purpose. Davidson seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were Yeas Buck, ^{Crubaugh} Davidson Harris Kay Melaney Trail Williams Conyer. Yeas 9 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted

Procure from
Pipe for Oxford
Street

Davidson reported that the amount of iron pipe furnished for the culvert across Oxford Street at the fill now being made was not sufficient and that the culvert would have to be extended one length of pipe on each side of the street and moved that the Committee in charge procure two more joints of pipe and have them placed seconded by Truitt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 9 nays none and the motion was declared carried.

Sidewalk on
North Park St

Davidson reported that the sidewalk over the stream on North Park Street was in bad condition and moved that the Clerk notify the owner of the property on which said sidewalk is to repair the same at once or the same would be done by the City at his expense.

Time in which
Early finish
College street

The Clerk asked for instructions in making the contract with C. M. Early for the graveling of College street as to the time in which to complete the work and the amount of the bond to be required and on motion of Harris the time was fixed at 45 days and the bond at three hundred dollars.

Set Stakes

On Motion of Davidson the Engineer was instructed to set stakes for sidewalk for Mr Rice on east side of Drunken Street north of the School house and on motion of Kay he was instructed to set stakes for sidewalks in the vicinity of the intersection of Broadway and Freedom Streets for property owners who desired to lower their walks.
