 Council met in regular session with  
 President Bush in the Chair and the

Pay ment of  
 bills

Minutes of preceding meetings read  
 and approved. A number of bills  
 against the City having been approved  
 by the finance Committee were read

bills referred

Harris asked for information relative to  
 bills of C. E. Hudson. F. L. Vessierat and  
 B. F. Mercer for work done at the well at  
 the corner of Main and Seneca streets  
 stating that the bills were in excess of the  
 amount appropriated for the work and  
 moved they be referred back to the finance  
 Committee to investigate and report at  
 the next meeting at which bills are paid.

Kay moved that the other bills as  
 read be allowed and that an Ordinance  
 be prepared providing for their payment  
 seconded by Trail and carried. The  
 Ordinance being prepared was read and  
 Harris moved the same be passed  
 seconded by Kay the yeas and nays were  
 called resulting Yeas Buck Davidson  
 Harris Kay Deput-Trail Williams Bush  
 yeas 8 nays none and the ordinance  
 was declared passed.

Clean dirt  
 from Arch st

Davidson moved that  
 the street Commissioner be instructed  
 to have the dirt cleaned off Arch Street  
 between Broadway and Oxford caused  
 by hauling dirt for the Oxford street fill  
 seconded by Deput- and carried.

Build Street  
 Crossings

Kay offered the following  
 resolution and moved its adoption  
 "Resolved that the Street Commissioner  
 be and is hereby instructed. at the  
 earliest practical moment to build

" Currier Street and Alley Crossings on  
 Freedom<sup>over</sup> and Broadway, Linden Ave  
 and High Street at points required  
 by reason of the grading of said  
 streets" Harris seconded the motion  
 to adopt. The yeas and nays were  
 called resulting Yeas 8 nays none and  
 the resolution was declared adopted

Grade Sidewalks

Harris called attention to  
 the necessity of grading the approaches  
 on the sidewalk to the streets recently  
 graded in the vicinity of Broadway  
 and Freedom street and moved it  
 be referred to the street Commissioner  
 and Street Committee with power to  
 act seconded by Truitt and Carried

repair Cellar  
 drain

Kay reported that in the  
 grading of High Street the cellar  
 drain from Mrs Lee's property had been  
 injured and moved that the Street  
 Commissioner be instructed to repair  
 the same seconded by Truitt and  
 Carried

To protect  
 dangerous places  
 in streets

Harris called attention to  
 the dangerous condition of the streets  
 in many places where grading is being  
 done on account of excavations not being  
 properly protected and moved that the  
 street committee notify all contractors  
 doing work for the city to securely  
 protect all dangerous places seconded  
 by Kay and Carried

Alley Crossing  
 on N Linden

Harris reported that the  
 alley crossings on Linden Avenue  
 north of Main street needed some  
 repairs and the matter was referred  
 to the street Committee to investigate  
 and report

On Motion of Truitt it was agreed  
 that when Council adjourns it be to  
 meet on Thursday evening Nov 5

relative to  
sewer injunction

Harris offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. "Whereas a claim is that under the orders made in the sewer injunction cases the city should take some steps to provide against the use of the sanitary sewers for sanitary sewerage even to the extent to which they are now being used. Resolved that the matter be referred to the sewer committee and City solicitor with instructions to report at next meeting of Council." Trail seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Davidson Harris Kay Seft Trail Williams Bush Yeas 8 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Lower water  
main

Kay reported that the grading of Broadway necessitated the lowering of the water main and Harris moved that the water works Company be ordered to lower the same seconded by Williams and carried Yeas 8 nays none.

sidewalk  
resolution

A resolution requiring the Water Works Company to construct a sidewalk in front of and along the west side of Lot no 1742 corner of Freedom street and Broadway was read and Harris moved the same be adopted seconded by Trail and carried Yeas 8 nays none.

A resolution requiring R. E. Hudson the owner of Lot no 1742 to construct a sidewalk along the north side of said lot was read and Davidson moved the same be adopted seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Davidson Harris Kay Seft Trail Williams Bush. Yeas 8 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Mayor's report The Mayor's report of \$74<sup>00</sup> Collected for fines and licenses for the month of October and turned over to the city Clerk was presented and on motion of Harris seconded by Trull accepted and ordered placed on file

Communication from Garrison

A communication from J. S. Garrison relative to the condition of the roadway to his gravel bank caused by the construction of the sanitary sewer through his property was read and on motion of Harris seconded by Trull referred to the sewer committee and Engineer to investigate and report
