Council met in adjourned session with president Bush presiding and the following members present: Conyer Davidson Harris Kay Deput Melaney Trail. absent Buck Lernbump Williams Wilson.

Street crossing  
Cambridge st

Harris moved that the Street Commission be instructed to construct a temporary Crossing ~~at~~ of binders or other material on Cambridge Street at the intersection of Freedom street seconded by Kay and carried

Trail moved that the Street Committee be instructed to construct three brick crossings on the north side of Patterson Street. one at Franklin street one at the alley west of Franklin street and one at the alley East of Franklin street seconded by Davidson and carried Yeas 5 nays none.

Attention was called to the necessity of an alley Crossing on the west side of Webb Street near the culvert and on motion of Harris seconded by Trail the matter was referred to the Street Committee with power to act

Clean up dirt  
on S Webb st

President Bush reported that South Webb Street was in bad condition owing to surplus dirt being left in the street from the sewer recently constructed and on motion of Conyer seconded by Deput the Clerk was instructed to notify Mr Auld to have the street put in good condition

The permanent Improvement Committee reported receiving an agreement from the Penna Co relation to the overhead bridges which the R R Co asked the Council to adopt and on motion of Kay seconded by Conyer the same was referred to the Permanent improvement Committee and solicitor to report at next meeting

Conger moved that the question of where the dirt so removed should be placed. and if ordered hauled to the approach for the proposed overhead bridge whether the Contractor be allowed pay for hauling be referred to the permanent improvement Committee seconded by Kay and carried
