

Ordinance No. December 3<sup>rd</sup> 1894

Council met in regular session with President Bush presiding and the following members present;

Buck & Davidson, Kay Melaney, Sept Trail Williams.

On motion of Buck the reading of the minutes was dispensed with

Reading of  
bills and  
Payment of  
same

a number of bills having been approved by the proper committees were read and Kay moved they be allowed as read and that an ordinance be prepared providing for their payment seconded by Williams and carried. The ordinance being prepared and there not being sufficient money in certain funds to pay the appropriations contained therein. Kay moved that there be appropriated from any unappropriated money in the treasury to the street fund \$156<sup>00</sup> and to the fire fund \$120<sup>00</sup> seconded by Williams and carried the ordinance was then read and Kay moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Trail. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Davidson Kay Melaney Trail Williams Bush. Yeas 7 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Mayor's report

The Mayor's report for the month of November showing fines and Licenses collected to the amount of \$45<sup>25</sup> was read, accepted and ordered placed on file.

Repair County

Melaney reported that some work was necessary to be done on Mahoning avenue south of the C & P R.R. and on motion of Trail the same was referred to the street committee with power to act.

Davidson moved that the street commissioner be instructed to make

at the intersection of City and Mechanic streets,  
Hester and Mechanic, Freedom and Second  
Patterson and north Liberty and on Noble  
Street East of Franklin, seconded by  
Trail and carried Yeas 8 nays none

On motion of Trail

Set Stakes

The engineer was instructed to  
set stakes for sidewalk on North  
Liberty street from Patterson to Reed  
Street and on Columbia Street on  
south side from the railroad west.

Specifications  
and Estimate of  
Cost of brick  
Culvert

The engineer presented  
specifications and an estimate of  
the cost of a brick arch culvert across  
the sidewalk on North Park Street  
and Davidson moved that the street  
Committee be instructed to have the  
work done in accordance with such  
specifications at a cost not to exceed \$108<sup>00</sup>  
seconded by Siefert. The yeas and nays  
were called resulting Yeas Davidson  
Melaney Siefert, Nay, Buck Kay  
Trail Williams Bush, Yeas 3 nays  
5 and the motion was declared lost

Motion to repair  
walk on Park  
Street

Kay moved that the street  
Commissioner be instructed to  
repair the sidewalk over the run  
on north Park Street at a cost  
not to exceed \$10<sup>00</sup>, seconded by  
Williams. The yeas and nays were  
called resulting Yeas Buck Kay  
Trail Williams Bush, Nay, Davidson  
Melaney Siefert, Yeas 5 nays 3  
and the motion was declared lost

Ordinance to  
repair walk

An Ordinance declaring  
it necessary to repair the sidewalk  
in front of Lots no 396 and 397,  
was read as follows: Be it ordained  
and enacted by the Council of the  
City of Alliance Ohio that it is

" necessary to repair the sidewalk in front of Lots  
 no 396 and 397 in this city by repairing the  
 underpinning, plankings and placing guard  
 rails along the same and that legal notice  
 be given to Mr R.W. Peters to repair the same  
 within ten days, served by the Marshal of  
 this city" Davidson moved the passage of  
 the Ordinance seconded by Trail and Carried  
 Yeas 8 nays none.

W.M. Reed to  
 repair walk

A resolution requiring W.M. Reed to repair  
 the sidewalk in front of his property on Arch  
 Street was read and on motion of Buck  
 seconded by McLaney Yeas 8 nays none  
 the same was adopted.

Sidewalks on  
 Main at

McLaney moved that the street  
 Commissioner be instructed to place cinder  
 on the sidewalk on Main Street in front of the  
 lot east of Erwin & Mell's Store, seconded by  
 Trail. The Yeas and nays were called  
 resulting Yeas Buck Kay McLaney Trail  
 Williams Bush Nays Davidson Sefert  
 Yeas 6 nays 2 and the motion was declared lost  
 Davidson moved that the street comm-  
 issioner relay said sidewalk with brick  
 at the expense of the city seconded by  
 Sefert. The Yeas and nays were called  
 resulting Yeas Davidson McLaney  
 Sefert nays Buck Kay Trail Williams  
 Bush Yeas 3 nays 5 and the  
 motion was declared lost

On motion Council adjourned
