

Council Chamber. Alliance O. Feby 4th 1895

Council met in regular session with the following members present Buesh, Harris, Kay, McLaney, Defert, Trail, Williams, Wilson, absent Bush, Conger, Crumbayh, Davidson. The President and Vice President both being absent. on motion of Harris Mr Kay was Chosen Chairman pro tem and on motion of Wilson the reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

Mayor's Report

The Mayor's report for the month of January of \$83⁰⁰ Collected for fines and licenses and the same paid over to the City Clerk was read and on motion of Buck seconded by Trail the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Report of Cemetery Trustees

The report of the Treasurer and secretary of the Cemetery board of Directors, ^{for year ending Dec 31-1894} was submitted showing cash on hand \$1471¹⁴ and Wilson moved the same be accepted and placed on file seconded by Defert and Carried.

Report on No. 4 Sewer

A communication from L. E. Chapin, reporting on a proposed change in the route of Sewer no 4 was read and on motion of Wilson seconded by Trail the same was referred to the sewer committee to report at next meeting.

Payment of bills

A number of bills against the city having been approved by the finance committee the same were read and Wilson moved that they be allowed as read and that an ordinance be prepared providing for their payment. seconded by Williams and Carried. The Ordinance upon being prepared was read and Wilson moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Defert. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck, Harris, McLaney, Defert, Trail, Williams, Wilson, Kay Yeas 8 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Harris reported that the case of Mary Ann Miller
 appropriate money against the City was assigned for trial on
 for Miller case Feb 5th and that it would be necessary
 to have some money to defray expenses and
 moved that there be appropriated for that
 purpose the sum of \$150⁰⁰ and that the same
 be placed in the hands of the Clerk to be
 applied to such expenses. seconded by Williams
 The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas
 Buck Harris Key McClary Inert Trail
 Williams Wilson. Yeas 1 nays none and the
 motion was declared carried.

 of the 6th ward to use the town hall in
 said 6th ward for holding meetings.
