

Council Chamber
Alliance Ohio April 22 1895

Council met in adjourned session with President Kay in the Chair and members all present except Conger.

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Bush moved that the election of G. J. Kay as chairman of Council which election had been had at the preceding meeting be made unanimous seconded by Geo. G. Williams and carried.

The Clerk presented ^{for the approval of Council} a list of 144 names of citizens selected by himself and the Mayor suitable to serve as Jurors in city cases for the ensuing year and Bush moved the same be approved seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 11 nays none and the motion was declared carried.

A Petition signed by Haine & Judd Jacob Oyster R. F. Carr and T. A. Burt asking that Simpson Street be improved by placing thereon four hundred loads of dirt and agreeing that if the request be complied with that they would haul on said street one hundred additional loads free of charge was referred to The Street Committee.

A petition asking for the improvement of Ash Street was presented as follows: To the City Council of Alliance Ohio - Gentlemen. We the undersigned hereby represent that it is necessary to improve Ash Street from the west side of the C & O. R. R. to the east side of Liberty Avenue by grading, draining and paving the same. And being owners of more than two-thirds feet front bounding and abutting on said improvement we hereby petition for said improvement and request the same be speedily constructed and that the ~~same~~ costs and expenses of

" the same be levied and assessed upon the abutting lands as your honorable body may determine.

We further request that your honorable body select such brick or paving block for this purpose as you may deem best and to specify the manner of construction

" and in consideration of said City Council granting this petition we each of us severally agree to hold the said city free from any expense from any properties being valued on the tax duplicate to low to discharge and pay our full share of the costs of said improvement, and

" in consideration as aforesaid we do hereby severally expressly waive all our statutory rights and privileges relating to the city's power to assess in such cases to 25% of the value of the property as assessed for taxation as provided in Section 2270 R.S. of Ohio

The Yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Cruborough. Love Seft. Trail J. R. Williams J. Y. Williams Wilson Kay Nays Bush Melaney. Yeas 9 nays 8 and the motion was declared carried.
