

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio May 6th 1845

Council met in regular session with members all present - except W. L. W. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Petition for
Lights

A Petition from residents of the 5th ward asking for an arc light to be placed at the intersection of High and Park Streets was referred to the Light Committee

W. & Water

A Petition from residents of the second ward asking for lights, water and street improvements was referred to the water and Light-Committees

Payment of
Claims

The finance Committee reported having approved a number of bills, and also presented a bill in favor of W. L. Boston for \$70⁰⁰ for attending the trial of Hartzell et al vs the city which was referred to the Judiciary Committee

The bills approved were read and Love moved that they be allowed as read and that there be an ordinance prepared providing for their payment seconded by Trail and carried. The Ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Bush. The Yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush Conger Crubaugh. Love Defeat Trail J. R. Williams J. G. William Wilson Kay Yeas 11 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

open alley

Love reported that Mr L. J. Beardsley desired to lay a sidewalk along his property on North Union Avenue and asked that the alley lying between his lot and the railroad be opened and the matter was referred to the Street Committee

Burch reported that certain parties were in the habit of depositing dirt and clay on the improved streets of the City particularly South Arch Street and on his motion the Marshal was ordered to notify all parties so offending to remove such dirt at once

To Vacate
Alley

A Petition was presented asking for the Vacation of the first alley north of Grant-street and running from Union Ave east to the first alley running north and south and the same was referred to the Street Committee to report at next meeting.

Repair Catch
Basins

Burch reported that a number of Catch basins covers in different parts of the City had become displaced and moved that the Street Commissioner be instructed to put them in proper position seconded by Conyer and Carried

Committee
on no 16

The Sewer Committee to whom was referred the proposed Change in the plan of Sewer no 16, reported as follows:
"The Sewer Committee to whom was referred the Matter of Changing the line of Sewer no 16. between Roseberry Street and the section line alley would report that the sewer can be placed on Union Avenue and we recommend that the Change be made" Signed Jas Defert A. B. Love O. C. Conyer, and on motion of Wilson seconded by Burch the report was adopted.

to L. C. Chapin.

Extension of
sewer no 27

The Sewer Committee
submitted the following report:
"The sewer Committee to whom was
referred the matter of making a contract
with Robert Learmonth for the extension
of lateral sewer no 27 would report that
Mr Learmonth is to construct the extension
ordered. The city to pay him the actual cost
and ten per cent additional also five
dollars per day for his services and the use
of his tools." Signed. J. Sargent A. B. Love
O. C. Conger. Conger moved the
report be adopted seconded by J. R. Williams
and carried Yeas 11 nays none

Land for sewer
disposal

Love called attention of Council
to the necessity of procuring the necessary
land for sewerage disposal and moved
the matter be referred to a committee of
three to investigate and report seconded
by Bush and carried and president
named the sewer committee.

Sewer on
North Freedom

Conger reported that the
open sewer or ditch on North Freedom between
the railroad and Patterson street was
in bad shape and moved the same
be referred to the sewer and street

Committees with power to act seconded by Frack
and carried yeas 11 nays none

Witherow's
Sidewalk

Bush reported that there were
several sidewalks bring put to grade on
Broadway between Arch and Linden Avenues
but that Mr Witherow had laid a walk on
the former grade which had been given him
by the city and now agreed that if the city
would do the grading he would remove the
walk and relay it to the now established
grade. and moved that the street commissioner
be instructed to put said walk to grade
and deposit the dirt on Oxford Street
seconded by Conger and Carried.

was read and Wilson moved the same be
adopted seconded by Buck and Carried Yeas
11 nays none.

A resolution requiring the owner
of Lots no ~~783~~ 883 and 884 ^{the sidewalk in front of} to grade said
lots to the established grade on Broadway
was read and Seft moved the same
be adopted seconded by Conger and Carried
Yeas 91 nays none.

A resolution requiring the owners
of Lot no 883 to grade the sidewalk along the
east side of said lot to the established grade
on Freedom street was read and
Buck moved the same be adopted seconded
by Conger and Carried yeas 11 nays none.

Wilson moved that the
sidewalk committee be instructed
to investigate the condition of the sidewalks

Throw out
sidewalks

in the different parts of the city and have any dangerous or defective walks either repaired or thrown out at their discretion.

Park street
sidewalk

Conger reported dangerous condition of the sidewalk across the stream on North Park Street near the school house and the same was referred to the sidewalk committee to report at next meeting.

Highland Park

Jno. Y. Williams moved that action on the motion adopted at the preceding meeting ordering the opening of the streets and alleys in Highland Park addition be delayed for two weeks. seconded by Buck seconded by Buck, the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Lovv Safert J. Y. Williams - Kay. Nays Bush Conger Lombough Trail. J. R. Williams Wilson. Yeas 5 nays 6 and the motion was declared lost.

Franchise for
Mutual Light Co

W. W. Lantier representing the Mutual Light Company addressed Council at this time stating that the Alliance Gas Co. The Electric Light and Power Company and the lighting plant of the Alliance Street Railway Company each of which had been granted the franchise to operate by the City had been consolidated into one company viz: The Mutual Light Company and asked that said Company be granted a franchise in lieu of those heretofore granted and on motion of Bush seconded by Wilson the matter was referred to the Judiciary Committee and engineers to report in one week.

Patterson st
Grade

Buck moved that the Patterson Street grade ordinance be taken from the table seconded by J. Y. Williams and carried Buck then moved the ordinance be placed on its final passage. seconded by J. Y. Williams Wilson moved to lay the ordinance on the

Bush moved that the grade committee
be instructed to investigate the existing grades
on the different streets in the city and report
with a view to amending any grades that
may be necessary, seconded by Conyer, and
carried.

to the grade committee to report at next meeting.

Chairs

Wilson offered the following resolution:
"Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance
that the Mayor be instructed to purchase a
sufficient number of Chairs to accommodate the
visitors in attendance at meetings of Council."

Buck moved the adoption of the resolution
seconded by Bush and carried yeas 11 nays none

Paper Mayor's
Office

Wilson called attention to the
necessity of papering and painting of the
Mayor's and Clerk's offices and moved that
the buildings and grounds committee
be instructed to have the same done, seconded
by J. R. Williams and carried yeas 11 nays none.

Kitzmiller's
Plat

The Platting Committee submitted
the following report: "The members of the
platting committee to whom was referred
the plat of Kitzmiller's addition beg leave to report
that the plat is in conformity with existing
streets and alleys so far as the owner of
the property has control of the same.
on motion of Wilson seconded by Trail the
report was accepted.

There being vacancies in

Health, Council proceeded to fill the same
as follows. Conyer moved that Dr Haggart
be appointed from the first ward, seconded
by Wilson The yeas and nays were called
resulting yeas 11 nays none and the
