

Council Chamber Alliance O May 13th 1895.

Council met in regular session with president Kay in the Chair and the following members present Bush Conger Cambaugh Love Trail J.R. Williams J.Y. Williams Wilson. absent Buck Melaney Defert.

A petition asking that the water main be extended west on Washington Street was presented and referred to the water committee.

The engineer presented plans, specifications and an estimate of the cost for the improvement of Ash Street from south Liberty avenue to the C. & P. R.R. and Wilson moved the same be adopted, seconded by Conger. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Bush, Conger, Cambaugh Love Trail. J.R. Williams J.Y. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 9 nays none and the same were declared adopted.

Ash Street
Resolution

The Clerk then read the following resolution: "Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, ^{Stark County} Ohio that it is hereby declared necessary to improve Ash Street in said city from the east side of Liberty Avenue to the Cleveland and Pittsburgh Railroad Company's right of way by grading the same to the established grade, paving the same with shale paving bricks or blocks to the width of fifty ³⁶ (50) feet, setting curb and gutter stones and constructing the necessary culverts and drains in accordance with the plans, profiles and specifications relating to said improvement together with the estimated cost ^{now} on file in the office of the City Clerk. The costs and expenses of said improvement shall be assessed per foot front upon the lots and lands abutting on said improvement. Said assessments shall

be payable in five annual installments and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments, and the Clerk is hereby directed to cause this resolution to be published for not less than two weeks in a newspaper published and of general circulation in said City and T.R. Jones Marshal of said City is hereby appointed to serve notice of the passage of this resolution upon the owners of ^{the} property abutting on said proposed improvement or in whose name said property is assessed for taxation upon the tax duplicate who are residents of Stark County Ohio

Amend Grade
on Union Ave

The Street Committee submitted the following report: "We the Committee on Streets and alleys beg leave to report favorable to and would recommend that the grade on Union Avenue be so amended as to make an even grade from the south side of City Street to the catch basin immediately north of the bridge" signed C.H. Bush, O.C. Conger Wilson moved the report be adopted seconded by J.R. Williams and carried Yeas 9 nays none

On motion of Trail the Street Commissioner was instructed to open the ditch on Ash Street at the south approach to the bridge now being constructed across Main Street.

A communication from W^m Runkle President of the Alliance Water Works Co relative to the purchase of the land required for sewer disposal plant in which he stated that their property was bonded and it

would be impossible for them to make a title was referred to the sewer committee and solicitor

The sewer committee submitted the following report: In the sewer committee to whom was referred the Webb Street sewer would recommend that the stone in the Culvert across Webb Street and under the sidewalk on the east side of said street be removed and 24 inch tile be put in place of same and be continued up to and across the alley west of Webb Street. and that the Catch Basin on Rush Street be rebuilt so as to catch the overflow from the R.R. Catch Basin. Provided the property owners liable to be damaged by any overflow that might occur will waive all right to damage against the city." signed A.B. Cove O.C. Conger

The Judiciary Committee to whom was referred the matter of granting franchises to the Mutual Light Co submitted the following report: "Your Committee to whom was referred the request of the Mutual Light Company to have such action taken by Council as will secure to said Company under its present corporate name the rights and privileges necessary to carry on its business in said City and to have the same made a part of the public record of the City, desire to report, The granting of this request will not in our judgment conflict with any former acts or grants of Council for the reason that the Mutual Light Company is the legal successor to the Alliance Gas Light Co, and the Electric Light and Power Co and purchased a part of the Lighting interest of the Alliance Street Railway Co, all of which Companies had Lighting privileges granted to them ~~and~~ by the City and exercised the same.

We would therefore recommend that such action be taken by Council as will comply with the request made by the Mutual Light Company and as a part of our report herein approve of and recommend the passage of an Ordinance entitled, An Ordinance granting a franchise to the Mutual Light Company to lay two pipes and erect
