

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio May 20 1895

Council met in regular session with President Kay presiding and the following members present. Buck Bush Love Trail J. G. Williams Wilson - absent Conyer Embrough Deput. J. R. Williams. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

The question of proceeding with the work on the Colleye street improvement was called up and Wilson submitted the following communication and waiver from the property owners on said Colleye street:

To The City Council Alliance Ohio - Gentlemen
 We the undersigned owners of property abutting on Colleye Street in the sixth ward of Alliance for the improvement of which the city has entered into a contract with Berlin & Middleton to grade curb and drain and excavate the same to such depth that eight inches of gravel will bring it to the proper grade of the street with a suitable sideslope or crown and the city has a contract with Charles Carley for placing the gravel on said street to the depth of eight inches (8") and as Mr H. C. Judd the one member of the Citizens Committee who gave the matter his personal attention and looked after the interests of the property owners in order to save additional expense in finding an outlet for the under drains had the pipes so placed as to be more than four feet below the top of the curbs in some places and at other places less than four feet below the top of the curbs near the east end of the street in order to secure a good outlet for the pipe. We hereby express our approval of the changes as made from original printed specifications and do hereby waive all legal rights that we might have to resist the payment of our assessment by reason of changes in the original specifications and we ask that the

The following communication was submitted: "We hereby agree to donate from E. C. Scranton the land necessary to extend Park Avenue South through to Oxford Street on Condition that the City fill up to grade the lot located on the east side of said Park Avenue extension and drain same with tile drain" signed E. C. Scranton. Kenneth Scranton an motion of Buck the same was referred to the Judiciary Committee and Solicitor Love called attention to the necessity of putting Grant Street to grade between Freedom and Arch streets and the same was referred to the street committee J. Y. Williams reported the necessity of grading Grant Street

submitted the following "Your committee to
whom was referred The opening and extension
of Washington street would report against any
extension of said street unless the property
owners on said street petition in proper form
and assume the damages resulting in such
extension" signed J. V. Buck A. B. Love
on motion of Trail seconded by Bush the report
was adopted.

Vine street
Bridges

Bush reported that the bridges
on Vine Street near the cemetery needed some
repairs and inquired whose duty it was to
keep the same in repair whether the city or
township trustees and the same was referred to
the street committee to investigate and report
and the street Commissioner was instructed
to make any repairs immediately necessary

Journal Entry
in sewer case

The solicitor submitted
a copy of the journal entry in the Common
Pleas Court in the sewer injunction cases
and the same was referred to the Judiciary
Committee

repair sewer

A communication from
Miss Koch asking Council to take some
steps to abate a nuisance near her property
caused by the machine street sewer was
referred to the sewer committee

Webb Street
sewer

Bush moved that the street
Committee proceed to remove the stone
from the Webb Street bridge and put
in tile in accordance with the report
of the sewer committee on that subject
on condition that the owner called for

Park Street
Bridge

in said report be given. seconded by
Trail and carried Yeas 7 nays none
Bush moved that
the sidewalk committee be instructed to
have the bridge or culvert on Park Street
near the school house extended west
to the lot line in accordance with a
proposition made by Mr. Cutler wherein
he agreed to pay for that portion of the
same extending across the sidewalk
seconded by McLaney. Bush moved
to amend by instructing the clerk to
advertise for the work seconded by
J. G. Williams and on motion of Trail
seconded by Bush the matter was
laid on the table for one week

McFadden's
Sidewalk

Attention was called
to the condition of the sidewalk along the
west side of Mr J. C. McFadden's property on
South Freedom Street the same being above
grade and the question of having it lowered
was referred to the street committee to report
at next meeting.

repairs on
Market Street

Bush reported that some
work was necessary on the Market Street
improvement in front of Thos Brosius'
property the curbing being out of place
thereby injuring the sidewalk and the
same was referred to the sidewalk
committee with instructions to have the
necessary repairs made

Cassady's
sidewalk

It was reported that the
sidewalk along the west side of A. S. Cassady's
property at the corner of Arch and Broadway was
considerably above grade and the same was
referred to the sidewalk committee

Change lights

The light committee to
whom was referred a petition ^{on May 14-1894} to change
the location of certain lights reported favorable
to such changes and recommended that
the same be done. Bush moved the

adoption of the report seconded by Melaney
and Bush then moved to table for one week
seconded by J. Y. Williams and carried

Park st grade

On motion of Bush the
engineer was instructed to prepare a grade
for Park street to conform to the now established
grades on Market and Broadway.

Oxford street

Bridge

The matter of procuring
the dirt necessary to complete the approaches
to the Oxford street bridge was on motion
of Bush referred to the Street and finance
Committees with power to act.
