Minutes of preceeding meeting read and approved.

Tax Levy for 1895

An Ordinance to levy taxes for municipal purposes was read and Bush moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Trail. The yeas and nays were called resulting. Yeas Buck Bush Conyer Embaugh Love Melaney Siefert Trail J. R. Williams J. Y. Williams. Kay. Yeas 11 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Special tax Levy 1895

An Ordinance to levy a special tax of one mill in addition to all other taxes levied for municipal purposes in pursuance of special authority therein set forth, was read and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Buck. The yeas and nays were called resulting. Yeas Buck Bush Conyer Embaugh Love Siefert Melaney Trail J. R. Williams J. Y. Williams. Kay. Yeas 11 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

The Street Committee

Submitted the following report

Webb Street Sewer

"We the committee to whom was referred the Webb Street Sewer by leave to make the following report: We found by careful measurement that it would take four hundred and twenty feet of tile; thirty feet of which would have to be double strength. We went to all our merchants dealing in such tile and gave them the dimensions and number of tile needed and Mr J. C. Crocker being the lowest we would recommend that

On Motion of Conger the street committee and engineer were instructed to prepare a plan for taking care of the water at the Union Ave bridge.

remove dirt
from Arch St

Attention was again called to the obstruction of South Arch street by certain parties placing dirt thereon and the solicitor reporting that there was an ordinance on the books prohibiting such obstructions. Bush moved that the Mayor be notified of the violation of such ordinance and that he proceed to enforce the same seconded by McLarty and Carried.

Vine Street
Bridge

T. G. Stanley township trustee bring present. stated that they the township trustees would repair the bridge on Vine Street near the cemetery and would ask that the street railway be remove their track from the bridge long enough to make the necessary repairs. and on motion of Love the Clerk was instructed to notify said railway company to that effect

land for Sewer
disposal

A Communication from Mr Wm Runkle president of The Alliance water works co. relative to the purchase by the city of a tract of land owned by said company to be used for a sewer disposal plant was submitted in which he asked that the city pay them \$5000 for said land and after some discussion Bush moved that the Clerk write Mr Runkle and make him an offer of \$2000 for the land recorded by Conger. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Bush Conger Trail J. R. Williams J. J. Williams Key. nays Bush Embaugh. Love Melaney Defeat Yeas 6 nays 5 and the motion was declared carried

first reading
of fire Dept
Ordinance

An Ordinance entitled an ordinance regulating the fire department and fixing the duties and powers of the Chief Engineer of the City of Alliance This was read first time and Bush moved that the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time. seconded by J. R. Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Bush Conger Melaney. J. R. Williams J. J. Williams. Nays Bush Embaugh. Love Defeat Trail Key Yeas 5 nays 6 and the motion was declared lost

On motion of Bush the report of the Committee on the Park street Culvert was taken from the table

Park Street
Culvert

Plans and specifications for said culvert were presented in accordance with instructions given at the preceding meeting. and on motion of Bush the said plans and specifications were amended by substituting the figures 6 and 3 feet for 5 and 2 1/2 feet thereby increasing the capacity of said culvert. Bush then moved that the plans and specifications be adopted and that the clerk advertise for bids for said work. seconded by J. F. Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas 11 nays 0 and the motion was declared carried.

Repair Alley
Crossings

On motion of Bush the street Commissioner was instructed to repair two alley crossings at the first alley ^{East} ~~West~~ of Arch and Columbia streets.

Repair Market
Street

Bush reported that at the point on Market Street where Mr Culp had constructed a lateral sewer across said street the pavement had settled and the clerk was instructed to notify Mr Culp to repair the same.

Change location
of Lights

On motion of Bush the report of the Light Committee relative to the changing of the location of certain Lights in the second ward. was taken from the table and the yeas and nays called on the adoption of the report resulting Yeas Bush Conger Loom Seft Melany J. R. Williams J. F. Williams Ray May Trail Yeas 9 nays 1. and the motion was declared carried. and the clerk was instructed to notify the Mutual Light Company of the adoption of said report.
