Payment of bills

A number of bills having been approved by the finance Committee were read and on motion of Love seconded by Trail the same were allowed as read and an Ordinance prepared providing for their payment. The ordinance was then read and Love moved the same be passed seconded by Conyer the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conyer Love Melaney Sufert Trail J. R. Williams J. Y. Williams Kay Yeas 9 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Trail reported that in building no 4 sewer that Patterson Street had been left in an unsatisfactory condition and the clerk was instructed to notify the contractor Mr Macauley to have the same put in good condition.

Resolution to  
Condemn  
Property

Love offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:  
"Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, <sup>Stark</sup> Ohio that it is hereby declared necessary and directed that for the purpose of making an out let for the present sanitary sewerage system of said City that a disposal plant be constructed according to the plans and profiles prepared by Consulting engineer Chapin and approved by the State Board of Health and which are now on file in the City Clerk's office on the tract of land owned by the Alliance water works company lying north of Gaskill street and west of Walnut street in the city of Alliance Stark County Ohio and also the land of said Water Works Company lying north of the above described tract and outside of the Corporation line, <sup>That</sup> the costs of said Plant be paid out of the sewer fund"

Melany seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called Naulting yeas Buck Conger Love Melany Deft Trail J.R. Williams J.F. Williams Kay Yeas 9 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted

Love offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:  
"Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that the Mayor of this City be instructed to serve notice of the pendency of the following resolution according to law upon the owners of property therein described:

to Condemn  
Property

The said resolution being as follows:  
Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance  
Stark County, Ohio that it is deemed necessary  
by said City and its intention is hereby declared  
to and it does hereby appropriate for the purpose  
of constructing a plant for the disposal of the  
sewage of the sanitary sewer system of the  
City of Alliance Ohio and for the purpose  
of connecting the said sewer system with  
said plant. the following described property is  
situated in the County of Stark and State  
of Ohio and known as that part of outlot number  
one hundred and two (102) and lying north of  
Gaskill and West of Walnut Street in said  
City also all the land of the Alliance water  
works Company in the south west quarter  
of section 24 Lexington Township Stark County  
Ohio extending extending north and west  
of said part of said outlot number 102.  
Excepting from said outlot no 102 a strip  
of land 60 by 200 feet on Gaskill Street on  
which the Grist mill is situated. The property  
hereby appropriated containing about  
13 acres. Also a right of way averaging five  
feet deep and six feet wide over outlot  
number 121. in the City of Alliance Stark  
County Ohio commencing at the present  
manhole on the south line of said outlot  
no 121 thence northwest across said lot to  
the north line of the same. That the solicitor  
is hereby authorized and directed to apply  
to a court of competent jurisdiction in the  
County for unpannelling a jury to make inquest  
into and assess the compensation to be paid for  
such property. That the costs and expenses of  
said appropriation be paid out of the sewer  
fund". Couyer seconded the motion to  
adopt the resolution to so instruct the  
Mayor. The Yeas and Nays were
