

Council Chamber Alliance O June 24th 1898

Council met in regular session with president Key in the chair and the following members present. Buck Bush Conyer Low Melaney Truil J.R. Williams J.Y. Williams Wilson. absent Sufert and Cornbough. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Plans for
Ash street

The engineer presented plans specifications and an estimate of the cost for the improvement of Ash Street from Liberty Avenue to the C & P R.R. and Bush moved the same be adopted seconded by Melaney. The year and maps were called resulting year 10 maps read and the same were declared adopted.

Resolution to
improve Ash
street

The following resolution was then read by the Clerk. Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that it is hereby declared necessary to improve Ash Street in said City from the east side of Liberty Avenue to the Cleveland and Pittsburgh Railroad Company's right of way by grading to the established grade, paving the same with shale paving bricks or block to a width of thirty six (36) feet, setting curb and gutter stones and constructing the necessary culverts and drains, in accordance with plans and specifications ^{now} on file in the office of the City Clerk.

The costs and expenses of said improvement shall be assessed per foot front upon the lots and lands abutting thereon. said assessments shall be ~~assessed per foot front~~ payable in five annual installments and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments and the

" Clerk is hereby directed to cause this resolution to be published for not less than two weeks in a newspaper published and of general circulation in the corporation and T R Jones Marshal of said City is hereby appointed to serve notice of the passage of this resolution upon the owners of property abutting on said proposed improvement or in whose name said property is assessed for taxation upon the tax duplicate, who are residents of Stark County Ohio." Bush moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Melaney the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush Boyer. Lovv Melaney Trail J. R. Williams J. Y. Williams Wilson Kay Yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

On Motion of Wilson the Grade Committee was instructed to prepare a grade Ordinance for Hartshorn street from Union Avenue to Penn street.

Purchase brick

Bush moved that the Clerk be instructed to purchase a car load of shale paving brick for street crossings seconded by Melaney and carried Yeas 10 nays none.

The engineer presented an estimate of the cost of the improvement of Union Ave at the P F W & C R R Bridge to take care of the water at that point and also gave a statement of the nature of the improvement

contemplated, and Conger moved the adoption of the report seconded by Wilson. Buck moved to lay the report on the table for one week seconded by Lorr and lost. The original motion was then carried and the report declared adopted.

Repair sewer
on Mechanic at

Conger reported that the storm water sewer was broken in in the alley between Main and Prospect streets near Mechanic leaving the same in a dangerous condition and moved that the street Commissioner be instructed to have the same covered over to avoid danger until such time as it can be repaired permanently repaired. seconded by Frail and carried.

The Committee on the Market Street improvement submitted the following report: "The undersigned citizens committee on Market Street hereby report that the Contractors McCallister Bros have completed the improvement according to the contract and to our satisfaction and we recommend that the same be accepted by the Council" signed J. C. Corvett. Wm Chambers. Citizens Com. H. R. Gyger City Engineer

Wilson moved that the report be accepted seconded by Frail. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas 10 nays none. and the report was declared accepted.

Rosenberry st

Buck reported that the sewer on Rosenberry street leading from Arch was in bad condition at the out-let and the same was referred to the sewer committee to report.

Lorr submitted a communication from Mr Lorr supt of the C & P R R

Communications from Loree relative to the construction of a sewer along the west side of the C & P R.R. from Ash street north across Main street, with an estimate of the cost, also an inquiry from Mr Loree as to, how much of the expense of such sewer the city would pay, it being understood that this would provide an outlet for the drainage from Ash street. The estimate being \$470⁰⁰ Loree moved that the city pay one half of the cost of the same viz \$235⁰⁰ seconded by Wilson and carried Yeas 10 nays none.

Inspect Canton Sewer disposal Visit Canton in a body on Thursday June 27 and inspect the plan of Sewerage disposal in use in that City. seconded by J.R. Williams and Carried. Bush then moved that there be appropriated the sum of \$26⁰⁰ to defray the expenses of the visit seconded by McLaney and Carried. Yeas 10 nays none
