

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio July 8. 1895

Council met in regular session with President Kay presiding and the following members present: Buck Bush Conger Crumbaugh Love Trail J.R. Williams J.Y. Williams Wilson. absent Sefert. Melaney arriving during the session

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved

An Ordinance Entitled.

"An Ordinance to assess a special tax on the real estate bounding and abutting on Market Street from Arch Street west to Union Avenue" was read first time and Love moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Buck. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas. Buck Bush Conger Crumbaugh Love Trail J.R. Williams J.Y. Williams. Wilson Kay. Yeas 90 nays none. The rules were declared suspended. The Ordinance was read second time by title and Bush moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read third time by title. seconded by J.R. Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas 10 nays none. The Ordinance was read third time by title. and Wilson moved the same be placed on its passage. seconded by Love. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas 10 nays none. and the Ordinance was declared passed.

On motion of Bush the Clerk was instructed to notify the Contractor for sewer no 27 to make Broadway street along the line of the sewer in passable condition and to remove the brick and other obstructions left on the street

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: "Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio. that the Alliance Street Railway Co having failed to comply with the provisions contained in an Ordinance passed December 10th 1888 granting said Company certain rights and privileges. that said company is hereby notified that unless the provisions contained in the above mentioned Ordinance are fully complied with within the next ten days the Council will proceed to revoke the entire franchise granted to said company". J. R. Williams seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Conger Crumbaugh Love Trail J. R. Williams G. G. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted

Street R.R.

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: "Whereas the Alliance Street Railway Company having secured an extension of their franchise over certain streets and parts of streets of Alliance and whereas the said Alliance Street Railway Company have not complied with the provisions of an Ordinance granting such extension: Therefore be it resolved that all the rights and privileges granted in an Ordinance passed June 19th 1893 granting the Alliance Street Railway Co the right to extend their Railway over the following streets or parts of streets be declared forfeited viz: Ely Street from from ^{north} Union Avenue west to the Corporation line. Lincoln Avenue from Ely Street to Vine Street and Wayne Street from North Union Avenue west to the Corporation line" J. R. Williams seconded the motion to adopt

The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Bush Bush Conger, Truitt, J. R. Williams Kay, nays Crubanyh Love J. G. Williams Wilson yeas 6 nays 4. and president Kay declared the resolution adopted.

Bush moved that the L. & A. R.R. be allowed to remove their sidetrack between Columbia and Market Street from its present location to the west side of Mechanic Street seconded by J. G. Williams Love moved the motion be tabled seconded by Bush and Carried

To forfeit Carley's

Bush moved that the Contract with C. M. Carley for the gravelling of College Street be declared forfeited on account of not having been complied with within the time specified in said Contract seconded by J. R. Williams. Conger moved to lay the motion on the table for one week seconded by Bush and Carried

ad for bids

On motion of Love seconded by Conger the Clerk was instructed to advertise for bids for completing the gravelling of College Street

Repair bridge on
North Liberty

Bush moved that the Street Committee be instructed to have the wooden structure over the run on north Liberty Street torn away and tile put in for the distance for which the city is liable seconded by J. R. Williams and Carried

Park Street
Culvert

On motion of Bush seconded by Conger the matter of providing retaining walls at the ends of the culvert now being built on Park Street was referred to the Street Committee with power to act.

Report of Water
Committee on
Extension to
Cemetery

The Water Committee submitted the following report. "The Committee on water beg leave to make the following report: After looking the ground over carefully we think that the best route to reach the cemetery would

be via Wayne street and Lincoln Avenue and we would recommend that the water main be extended as per the above route in accordance with the proposition of ~~The Water Works Co~~ namely that three plugs be placed on said route instead of seven as would be required on the Contract. The rental for the three plugs having been provided for for the first two years" signed O. C. Conger A. B. Love.

Wilson moved the adoption of the report seconded by Bush and Carried. and on motion of Bush the Clerk was instructed to notify the Water Works Co of the above action of Council.

Claim of Mrs Campbell
 A communication from Baldwin & Shields attorneys for Mrs Campbell stating that the Supreme Court had sustained the decisions of the lower Courts in the case of Campbell vs the City of Alliance and asking that immediate payment of the judgment be made. was referred to the Finance Committee

Report of Judiciary Com on bills
 The Judiciary Committee to whom had been referred a number of bills at the preceding meeting reported in favor of paying the same and on motion of Bush the report was adopted.

Change name of street
 Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption; Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that a street in the sixth ward known as Walnut Street be changed to the name of Hartshorn Street. Trail seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas 11 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted

McFadden's sidewalk
 Bush reported that Mr J. E. McFadden had at one time laid a sidewalk along the west side of his lot on South Freedom Street in accordance with the then established grade. and the grade having since been changed made it necessary that said sidewalk be lowered
