

Council Chamber Occurrence Ohio July 22, 1895

Council met in regular session with  
President King in the Chair and the following  
members present: Buck Bush Conger Lovv

and approved.

Payment of Special  
election

An Ordinance to provide for the payment  
of the expenses of the special election held July 20  
was read and Lovv moved the same be passed  
seconded by Bush. The yeas and nays were called  
resulting yeas Bush Conger Lovv Siefert Melaney  
Truitt J. Y. Williams Wilson King. Yeas 9 nays 0  
and the Ordinance was declared passed.

An Ordinance entitled

was read first time and Lovv moved that the rules

On motion of Bush the street  
 Commissioner was instructed to repair a bridge or  
 Culvert near the east end of Grant street.

dirt on  
South Arch st

It being reported that certain  
 persons were depositing dirt on South Arch street  
 and refused or neglected to remove same when  
 ordered to do so, Bush moved that the matter be  
 referred to the City Solicitor to report at next meeting  
 as to the manner in which the Council could enforce such  
 orders.

Repair Crossing

Bush moved that the Street Commissioner  
 be instructed to tear out the old trunk or box at the  
 Cemetery gate and put in a new one seconded by Conger  
 and Carried.

Resolution  
Stop work  
on Streets

Melaney offered the following resolution:  
 Be it resolved ~~that~~ by the Council of the City of Alliance  
 Ohio that no more work be done on the streets this season  
 unless ordered by Council." Conger moved the same be  
 adopted seconded by Traill. Bush moved to amend  
 by adding: except such work as is absolutely  
 necessary to avoid accident or injury seconded by  
 Conger and Carried. The Yeas and nays were then  
 called on the motion as amended resulting Yeas 9 nays 1  
 and the resolution was declared adopted. (William Votaw mo)

Bids for lease  
of ground

Trail submitted bids received by the bridge Committee for the lease of the ground under the south approach to the bridge. The solicitor reported that the city would have no right to make such lease to any one without first advertising for bids as provided by law, and on motion of Bush seconded by Seft the advertising for such lease was referred to the Bridge Committee Solicitor and Clerk.

Boston be accepted on condition that he complete the work within 30 days from the signing of the contract and that he give a good and sufficient bond for the performance of the same, seconded by Wilson the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Bush Low J. Y. Williams Wilson Kay nays lawyer Melaney Seft Trail yeas 6 nays 4 and the motion was declared carried.

The clerk reported that there was not sufficient funds in the treasury to the credit of the Colley's street fund to provide for the above contract and on motion of lawyer the matter was referred to the solicitor to report at next meeting.

We the undersigned Mayor and Clerk of the City of Alliance Ohio hereby certify that we have this day canvassed the returns of the special election held in said City on July 20<sup>th</sup> 1895 at which a proposition was submitted to issue the bonds of the City in the sum of \$20,000 for the purpose of Constructing a sewer disposal works and find that the total number of votes cast was 577, and that "For the issue of bonds Yes" had 491 votes and "For the issue of bonds no" had 86 " signed. B. F. Prescott Mayor and Thomas Casselman Clerk.

On motion of Bush seconded by Conger the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.
