

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio August 12th 1895
Council met in regular session with President
Hay presiding and the following members present,
Buck, Conger, Crubaugh Love, Melaney, Sefert,
Trail, J. R. Williams, J. G. Williams Wilson
Absent Bush. Minutes of preceding meetings
read and approved.

Mayor's report of July showing fines and licenses to the amount
of \$66⁵⁰/₁₀₀ collected was presented and on motion
of Trail the same was accepted and ordered placed
on file

Passage of Claims ordinance
Love of the finance Committee reported
that the committee had approved in addition
to the bills approved at the preceding meeting
a bill in favor of B. F. Prescott for \$12⁰⁰/₁₀₀ for a
revolver furnished the police department and
a bill of Thos Richards for \$2¹⁰/₁₀₀ for labor and
mwood they be allowed and ^{be} placed in the
claims ordinance, seconded by Trail and carried
The bills were placed in the Claims Ordinance
which had failed to pass at the preceding
meeting and the ordinance was read and
Love moved the same be passed seconded
by Wilson. The yeas and nays were called
resulting Yeas Buck, Conger, Love, Sefert
Trail, J. R. Williams J. G. Williams Wilson, Hay
Nay Melaney. Yeas 9 nays ~~one~~ and the Ordinance
was declared passed.

repair bridge
Buck reported that the bridge
at the intersection of North Walnut and north
Freedom Street needed some repairs and
moved that the street committee be
instructed to make the necessary
repairs seconded by Trail and carried.

adoption of plans for sewer disposal
Love moved that the
plans presented by Consulting Engineer Chapin
at the preceding meeting for a sewer disposal
plant be adopted subject to the approval of the
State Board of Health, seconded by Trail
The yeas and nays were called resulting

Yeas Buesch, Conger, Love, McLaney, Defert, Frail, J. R. Williams, J. G. Williams, Wilson, Kay. Yeas 10 nays none and the plans were declared adopted.

Accept bid of
Hawon & Middleton
on Ash street

Love moved that messrs Hawon & Middleton whose bid for the paving of Ash Street had been accepted be allowed to proceed with the work without a contract if they so desired, and at their own risk of securing a contract seconded by J. R. Williams and carried.

Grade alley

Conger reported the necessity of grading the first alley north of Broadway and ~~east~~ west of Freedom Street and moved to refer to the street committee with power to act, seconded by Defert and carried.

Resolution to not
sell bonds

Love offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: "Be it resolved, that the clerk be instructed to not sell the \$1000 sidewalk bonds now advertised." Defert seconded the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buesch, Conger, Crumbaugh, Love, Defert, McLaney, Frail, J. R. Williams, Wilson, Kay, Kay, J. G. Williams, Yeas 9 nays one and the resolution was declared adopted.

Set grade stakes

Conger moved that the Engineer be instructed to set grade stakes for sidewalks for J. Myers on Prospect Street and for the Board of Education on Broadway seconded by Wilson and carried.

Advertise for
bids for lease
of ground

A form of advertisement for bids for the lease of ground under the Main Street bridge was presented and on motion of Wilson the same was adopted and on motion of Love seconded by Conger the clerk was instructed to advertise for bids for said lease for a term of two weeks.

High street
Grade ordinance

An Ordinance to establish a grade on High Street was read second time and Wilson moved that the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read third time by title seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas 11 nays none. The rules were declared suspended, the ordinance was read third time by title and Buck moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Conger, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Crumbaugh Love. Melaney Siefert Trail J.R. Williams J.Y. Williams. Wilson Kay, Yeas 11 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Report of building
and grounds
Committee

The Building and grounds committee to whom was referred the request of Mr Taylor for the lease of the city lot on Mechanic street reported as follows: "The Committee to whom was referred the leasing of the city lot for a coal yard would report that in their opinion it would not be expedient to lease the same" signed J.W. Buck, Thomas Wilson, Love moved the adoption of the report seconded by Conger and carried.

Ordinance to
accept Kitzmiller
addition

An Ordinance to accept Kitzmiller's addition was read first time and Buck moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title. seconded by Crumbaugh. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Crumbaugh Love Siefert Trail J.R. Williams J.Y. Williams Wilson Kay Nays Conger Melaney yeas 9 nays 2. The rules were declared suspended the ordinance was read second time by title and Buck moved that the rules be again suspended and the ordinance be read third time by title seconded by Wilson. and carried yeas 9 nays 2. The ordinance was read third time by title and Buck moved the same be passed seconded by Crumbaugh. the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Crumbaugh

The report of the Marshal Mr
J R Jones. of having served notice of the passage
of a resolution to improve, was submitted
as follows: "To — You are hereby notified
that a resolution was adopted by the Council
of the City of Alliance on the 15th day of July 1895
declaring it necessary to improve the first
Alley south of and parallel with Main Street
from the public square west to Lindsey Avenue
by paving the same with brick setting curb and gutter
stones and constructing the necessary Calverts and
drains in accordance with plans and specifications
on file in the office of the City Clerk. The Cost and
expense of said improvement to be assessed per
foot front upon the property abutting on said
improvement payable in two annual
installments"

The rules were declared suspended the Ordinance was read second time by title and Wilson moved the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read third time by title seconded by Conger. The yeas and nays were called resulting, same as before Yeas 11 nays none. The rules were declared suspended and the ordinance read third time by title and Buck moved the passage of the same seconded by J.R. Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conger Combaugh Love Melaney Defert Trail J.R. Williams J.G. Williams Wilson Nays. Yeas 11 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

The rules were declared suspended the ordinance was read third time by title and Conger moved it be placed on its final passage seconded by Trail. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conger Combaugh Love Melaney Defert Trail J.R. Williams J.G. Williams Wilson Nays. Yeas 11 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

The Telephone company having
