 Consulting engineer reporting the approval

 for the city of Alliance was submitted
 and on motion of Bush the same
 was received and ordered placed on file

Street Railway
 to relay track

Bush offered the
 following resolution and moved its
 adoption: Be it resolved by the council
 of the city of Alliance Ohio that the Alliance
 Street Railway Company be and are hereby
 granted the privilege to relay their
 track by using the regular T Rail
 from the present terminus in the 6th
 ward to Milner street and from
 Milner Street to the P.F.W & Co Depot
 by using the Standard Girders rail."

J.R. Williams seconded the motion
 to adopt. The yeas and nays were
 called resulting. Yeas 7 nays none
 and the resolution was declared
 adopted.

Street Committee
 to make bill
 on Columbia st

Bush moved that the
 street committee be allowed to
 make the necessary fill on Columbia
 Street between Mechanic and Arch
 to widen the street out to the curb line
 seconded by J.R. Williams. The yeas and
 nays were called resulting Yeas Buck
 Bush Trail J.R. Williams J.G. Williams Stay. Yeas 6
 nays 0 and the motion was declared carried

Repair
Rosenberry
Street

Bush reported the necessity of some work on Rosenberry Street west of the railroad and moved that the street Commissioner be instructed to place 15 inch tile across the street just west of the railroad and to make the necessary fill with the material most available. seconded by J.G. Williams and carried.

Remove Lumber
from Ash street

On motion of Bush the Clerk was instructed to notify the Contractors for the Main Street bridge to remove the lumber from Ash Street.

Repair alley

Bush moved that the Street Commissioner be instructed to repair the first alley east of Freedom street between Market and Main Streets. seconded by J.R. Williams ^{Carried} and.

Vault at
city prison

Attention was called to the filthy condition of a vault in the rear of the city prison and on motion of Toval seconded by Bush the same was referred to the Sidewalk Committee

Repair Sewer

On motion of Bush the Clerk was instructed to notify the sewer Committee to repair sewer on Liberty Street

and for bids

On motion of Love the Clerk was instructed to advertise for bids for the improvement of the first alley south of Main Street between the public square and Linden Avenue
