

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio Aug 26th 1895

Council met in regular session with President Kay in the chair and the following members present:

Buck, Bush, Crumbaugh, Love, Trail, J.R. Williams, J.Y. Williams, Wilson, Abert, Conger, Melaney, Sefton.

Grade stakes

A communication from G.K. Pritchard asking for the grade in front of his lots on Mechanic Street was referred to the sidewalk Committee

College street
Drain

Buck reported that a drain from the College street improvement needed to be extended further north and moved that the matter be referred to the street Committee with power to act seconded by Crumbaugh and carried.

Repair alley

Bush reported that some work was necessary in the alley in the rear of W^m Line's property on Market street and moved the same be referred to the street Committee with power to act, seconded by J.R. Williams and carried

Sewer disposal
Ordinance

An Ordinance to provide for the erection of a sewer disposal plant. Was read first time and Love moved the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Bush the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Bush Crumbaugh Love Trail J.R. Williams J.Y. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 9 nays none. The rules were declared suspended the ordinance was read second time by title and Bush moved that the rules be again suspended and the ordinance be read third time by title seconded

" by J. R. Williams and carried yeas 9 nays 0
 " The Ordinance was read third time by
 title and Love moved that the same be
 placed on its passage seconded by Buck
 " The yeas and nays were called resulting
 yeas Buck Bush Crumbaugh Love Trail
 J. R. Williams J. G. Williams Wilson Kay
 " Yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was
 declared passed.

Ordinance to
 appropriate
 land

An Ordinance to appropriate
 Real Estate for the Construction of a sewer
 disposal works. was presented ^{by Love} and read
 and Bush moved that the rules be
 suspended and the Ordinance be read
 second time by title. Seconded by J. R.
 Williams. The yeas and nays were called
 resulting yeas Buck Bush Trail
 J. R. Williams Stays Crumbaugh Love
 J. G. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 4 nays
 5. and the motion was declared lost.

Give notice
 of above

Love then offered the
 following resolution and moved its adoption:

Resolved that the Mayor of the City of
 Alliance Ohio be and is hereby instructed to
 cause written notice to be given to the
 owners of the following real estate situated
 in said City: Beginning at a point on the
 north line of Keystone Street, 1125.3 ^{feet} west of the east
 line of the north west quarter of section 25 being the
 south east corner of out lot no 125 in said city
 thence north 150.72 feet thence east 105.6 feet
 thence north 216.9 feet thence west 110.22 feet
 thence north 30° west 30.76 feet thence
 south to the north line of Keystone Street
 thence east 20 feet to the place of beginning;

of the pendancy of an Ordinance
 to appropriate said land for sewer
 disposal purposes. and that Thos. R. Jones
 Marshal of said City is hereby appointed
 to serve said notices. Trail seconded
 the motion to adopt. The yeas and

nays were called resulting yeas Buck
Bush Leubach Lovv Trail J.R. Williams
J.Y. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 9 nays
none and the resolution was declared
adopted.

The sidewalk committee
submitted the following report:

Report of Sidewalk
Committee

"The undersigned committee to whom
was referred the question of putting to
grade the sidewalks of Mr Randolph
and Wickersham beg leave to report
that in the opinion of the committee
the city is not liable and would recommend
that the City Clerk be instructed to notify
the owners of the above sidewalks to that
effect - (Signed) C.H. Bush, J.W. Buck
J.Y. Williams. Williams stated

the report should read "that the
city is liable" instead of "not liable"
Bush stated that the wording of the
report as read was the report of the
majority of the committee. and moved
the adoption of the report. seconded
by J.R. Williams The yeas and nays
were called resulting yeas, Buck Bush
Lovv Leubach & Trail J.R. Williams
Kay Wilson. Aye. J.Y. Williams
Yeas 8 nays 1 and the resolution was
declared adopted.

Bush offered the following resolution
and moved its adoption. Resolved by the
Council of the city of Alliance Ohio that the space between the
property line and all sidewalks laid after this date be two
feet unless otherwise ordered by Council. Buck seconded
the motion to adopt. The yeas and nays were called resulting
Yeas 8 nays 1. (J.Y. Williams Voting) no. and the resolution
was declared adopted. On motion of Buck
the street Commissioner was instructed to fill
up an old well on Roseberry Street. and
thereupon Council adjourned.
