

Council Chamber Alliance O Sept 30th 1895

Council met in regular session with President Kay in the chair and the following members present. Buck Crumbaugh Love Melaney Trail, J. R. Williams, J. Y. Williams Wilson. Absent Bush, Conger and Siefert Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Buildings standing in alley

Melaney reported that in the improvement of the alley between the public square and Linden avenue it was discovered that several of the buildings on each side of the alley were built out past the lot lines some of them being nine inches on the alley, and Wilson moved that the specifications be so changed as to make the improvement 20 feet wide instead of 22 feet, ^{on condition that the property owners agree to such change} recorded by J. Y. Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting Geo. Melaney, J. R. Williams, J. Y. Williams, Wilson, Kay, Noyes Buck, Crumbaugh, Trail Yeas 6 nays 3 and the motion was declared carried

Water Wks Co to repair street

On motion of Buck the Water Works Company were ordered to repair the street at the corner of Grant and Arch.

Petition against change of grade on North Union Ave

A Petition signed by a number of property owners on north Union Avenue and Prospect street protesting against any change of grade on North Union Avenue between Main street and the P F W & C R R was presented, and J. Y. Williams moved that the request of the petitioners be granted seconded by Trail and Carried

Obstruction in alley

Trail called attention to an obstruction in the first alley west of Webb Street and the same was referred to the street Committee with Power to act

Repair alley

Mr Jones reported some work needed in an alley near his property and on motion of Trail the same was referred to the street Committee

Free Fair

A communication from the managers of the Free Fair association asking that they be granted the use of the streets of the city for the purpose of holding a street fair on the 18th and 19th of October. Wilson moved that the request be granted seconded by Trail and Carried.

against Street R.R.
Laying track

J. D. Lewis asked that Council take some action on the protest filed at the Special meeting Sept. 26th regarding the relaying of the street Railway tracks which had been referred to the street Committee and Wilson moved that the matter be taken from the Street Committee and that a ^{special} committee of three be appointed with the solicitor to investigate and report at next meeting and if the work is not being done in accordance with the franchise they to have power to act and stop the work, seconded by Trail and Carried and President Kay appointed as said committee. File for street in
6th ward

Wilson reported that it was necessary to procure some tile to be used on Cherry Street in the 6th ward and moved that the matter be referred to the Street Committee with power to act, seconded by J. G. Williams Lovv moved to amend by instructing the Committee to report at next meeting seconded by Duck and Carried.

Put in alley
Crossings

Wilson moved that the street Commissioner be instructed to put in two alley crossings on the north side of Colleyr street seconded by J. G. Williams and Carried.

Lovv moved that the Street Commissioner be instructed to put the alley crossings on Park street between Market and Main street to grade, seconded by Trail and Carried.

Lovv presented a bill in favor of L. C. Chapin for \$495⁰⁰ for services in

preparing plans and specifications for sewer disposal works and moved the same be allowed and that an ordinance be prepared providing for their payment of the same seconded by Trail and carried. The ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved the same be passed seconded by Trail. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Crumbaugh Love Melaney Trail J. G. Williams J. R. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 9 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Sec 1 Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that it is deemed necessary and its intention is hereby declared to and it does hereby appropriate to public use for the purpose of Constructing thereon a sewer disposal works in accordance with an Ordinance of this City passed August 26 1890 the following described property situated in the City of Alliance Starke County Ohio: Beginning at a point on the north line of Keystone Street 1125.13 feet west of the east line of the northwest quarter of section 25 being the southeast corner of out lot no 125 in said city thence north 150.72 feet thence east 105.6 feet thence north 216.9 feet thence west 110.22 feet thence north 30° west 30.76 feet thence south to the north line of Keystone Street thence east 20 feet to the place of beginning

To appropriate

Sec 2. That the city solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to apply to a Court of Competent jurisdiction in this County for impaneling a jury to make inquiry into and assess the Compensation to be paid for such property.

Sec 3. That the cost and expense of said appropriation be paid out of the sewage disposal fund

Sec 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

An Ordinance entitled. "An Ordinance to appropriate real Estate for the construction of a sewage disposal works" was then read. (bring the ordinance introduced August 26th 1895)

" and Wilson moved the same be passed. seconded by Buck. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck. Combaugh, Love, Melaney, Trail J. G. Williams J. R. Williams Wilson Nays Yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed

" Love moved that the Mayor be instructed to prepare and that T. R. Jones be authorized to serve notice to the property Owners that application will be made to the Probate Court of Stark County Ohio to assess Compensation for appropriation of Garrison property October 7th 1895. seconded by Wilson and Carried

" Mr S Joliat submitted the following proposition. To the City Council Alliance Ohio. "I propose to take out the stone of the Culvert and side Channel on Webb Street and give \$150.00 for same". Love moved to refer the proposition to the sewer committee to report at next meeting. seconded by Wilson and Carried.

Trail moved that the motion to tear up Mr Butler's sidewalk on Webb Street which was adopted at the preceding meeting be reconsidered seconded by J. G. Williams and Carried
