Council met in regular session with President Kay presiding and the following members present, Buck Bush, Crumbaugh, Love, Melaney, Trail, J.R. Williams, J.Y. Williams, Wilson. Absent Conyer, and Siefert.

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Payment of bill of Costs in Kayler case

A communication from R.S. Kayler presenting a bill for attorney fees and expenses incurred by him in the appropriation case brought by the city against him, of \$317.<sup>25</sup> was ~~received~~ submitted also a proposition from Mr Kayler that if the city would pay him \$275<sup>00</sup> he would be satisfied. Love moved that the bill be allowed seconded by Bush. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush, Love, J.R. Williams, J.Y. Williams, Wilson, Kay, nays Crumbaugh, Melaney, Trail. Yeas 7 nays 3. and the motion was declared Carried.

accept Garrison's Proposition for land

Love reported that Mr J.C. Garrison had agreed to take \$500<sup>00</sup> for the ground owned by him and sought to be appropriated by the city for sewer disposal purposes, and moved that the same be accepted seconded by Wilson and carried. Yeas Buck Bush, Crumbaugh, Love, Trail, J.R. Williams, J.Y. Williams, Wilson, nays Melaney. Yeas 7 nays 1

Ordinance to Pay Kayler

Love moved that an Ordinance be prepared providing for the payment to R.S. Kayler of the bill of Costs in the appropriation case viz \$275<sup>00</sup> seconded by Bush and carried. The ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved the same be passed seconded by J.Y. Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Bush, Love, J.R. Williams, J.Y. Williams, Wilson, Kay, nays Crumbaugh, Melaney, Trail. Yeas 7 nays 3 and the ordinance was declared passed.

Melaney reported that the street  
Commissioner would put 110 loads of  
gravel on Union Avenue 1 1/4 yards at a  
load for the sum of \$100<sup>00</sup> and that  
Mr W W Cantine would advance  
the street Commissioner the money to

the city would have the money in fund  
to pay the same, and J. Y. Williams  
moved the adoption of the report  
seconded by Melaney and carried.

seconded by J. R. Williams and carried.

& McKinney in the sum of \$6600<sup>00</sup> with  
W. J. Peiro and L. A. LaChiot as surety  
for the faithful performance of the  
same, and after the Clerk certifying  
that the money was in the treasury to  
the credit of the sewage disposal fund  
necessary for said Contract Love offered  
the following Resolution. Resolved that  
the bond of Duffy Peiro and McKinney  
be approved and that the Mayor be  
instructed to sign contract in behalf  
of the city when the city secures the

Harter as sureties for the faithful performance of said Contract was read and after the Clerk certifying that the money required for the said Contract was in the treasury to the credit of the sewage disposal fund and not appropriated to any other purpose. Lora offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. Resolved that the bond of the Bonnat Co be approved and the Mayor be instructed to sign Contract on behalf of the City when the City secures the Garrison Property. Wybrecht Sons and J. G. Tolerton as sureties for the faithful performance of said Contract was read and after the Clerk certifying that the money required for the said Contract was in the treasury to the credit of the sewage

J. be approved and that the Mayor be instructed to sign contract on behalf of the city when the city secures the "Garrison property". Bush seconded the motion to adopt. Have Guardian  
 appointed

Love reported that one of the Garrison heirs having an interest in the land purchased for sewerage disposal works was under the age of 21 years and on motion of Frail the solicitor was instructed to notify Mr Garrison to have a guardian appointed for said minor so that the city might secure a clear title to the property.

Repair Streets  
 and Sidewalks

Superintendent Morris of the public schools called attention to the necessity of street crossings at Pike and Franklin streets and at Broadway and Park streets also Cinder walks on Oxford street where the fill was recently made and on motion of Love the same was referred to the street committee.

Sidewalk  
 Resolution

Bush offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: "Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio that it is hereby declared necessary and that sidewalks shall be constructed of brick or stone to a width of six feet and in accordance with the

Ordinances of this city on south Arch street  
 along the entire front of lots no 2423, 2425,  
 2424, 2426 1948, 1949, 1950-1951 and  
 1947, except except 60 feet front off said  
 lot no 1947 also along the entire front of  
 out Lot no 1946 in said city and the  
 Mayor is instructed to cause notice to be  
 served upon the owners of of each side of  
 said lots of the passage of this resolution.

J. R. Williams seconded the motion  
 to adopt. The Yeas and nays were  
 called resulting Yeas Buck Bush  
 Crumbaugh Love Melaney Trail J. R. Williams  
 J. Y. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 10 nays  
 none and the resolution was declared  
 adopted.
