Council met in regular session with President

On motion of Love the reading  
 of the minutes was dispensed with

Contract for  
 fire hose

Love of the finance committee  
 reported that the committee had an offer  
 from the W. H. H. Peck Co of Cleveland to  
 furnish the city with 500 feet of Eureka  
 and 500 feet of Paragon fire hose for the sum  
 \$950<sup>00</sup>. The Eureka at 90<sup>cts</sup> per foot and the  
 Paragon at 80<sup>cts</sup> per foot. and presented  
 an article of agreement signed by the  
 W. H. H. Peck Co whereby they agreed to  
 sell the city the above amount of hose  
 at the price named. to be paid for  
 Feb'y 25 1896. and August 25. 1896  
 said hose to stand a water pressure of  
 400 pounds to the square inch and warranted  
 from any defects in manufacture and agreeing  
 to replace such hose within a period of  
 36 months. Love moved that the Mayor  
 and Clerk be authorized to sign said  
 Contract or article of agreement on  
 behalf of the City. seconded by J R. Williams  
 and carried.
