Council met in regular session with President Kay Presiding and the following members present. Bush Conger Love Melany Supt Trail J. G. Williams Absent Bush Coribough. J. R. Williams. Wilson.

Minutes of preceding meetings read and approved.

Petition to amend grade on Roseberry

A petition from property owners on Roseberry Street asking that the grade on said street be amended by lowering at least one foot. was on motion of Trail referred to the grade committee.

Mayer's report

The Mayor's report for the month of October of fines and licenses to the amount of \$498 and same paid to city clerk was presented and on motion of Love ordered received and placed on file.

Report of Cemetery Trustees 1895

A report from the Cemetery Trustees for the quarter ending Sept 30th showing balance in hands of treasurer of \$728⁵⁰ and in hands of Secretary 241²⁰ total 969⁷⁰ was presented and on motion of Love received and ordered placed on file.

Resignation

W. J. W. Woolgar

A communication from W. J. W. Woolgar tendering his resignation as a member of the Board of Health from the Third ward was read and Trail moved the resignation be accepted seconded by Conger and carried.

Petition for City Sealer

A petition signed by J. B. Brown and 40 others asking Council to create the office of city sealer of weights and measures was presented and on motion of Bush referred to the Judiciary Committee.

A Petition signed by property owners along the line of the first-alley south of Main street and running from Arch to Mechanic street - asking Council to have the same put to an Established Grade was on motion of Love referred to the street Committee

Payment of
October bills

The finance Committee reported having approved a number of bills stating that they were in the hands of the Clerk and asked that they be read. The bills were read and Love moved that they be allowed as read and that an ordinance be prepared providing for their payment. The ordinance being prepared and there not being sufficient money in the street fund to pay the appropriations contained therein Love moved that there be appropriated from any unappropriated money in the treasury to the street fund \$250⁰⁰ seconded by Trail and Carried. The Ordinance was then read and Love moved the same be passed seconded by Conyer. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conyer Love Melaney Trail Defert J. G. William Kay. Yeas 8 nays none. and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Buck offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: Whereas, Chas. H. Bush representing the Third ward of the city as member of this Council, secured by public subscription certain funds for the extension of the water main to the public cemetery and

Whereas the said subscription list has not been delivered by the said Chas. H. Bush to the City Clerk as provided for therein
Now therefore, be it resolved that the City Clerk is hereby instructed to demand the immediate delivery by the said

Chas. H. Bush of the said subscription list and all monies collected thereon to the city Clerk. Conyer seconded the motion to accept the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conyer Egan McLainy Arfert Drail J. J. Williams Kay. Yeas & nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

McLainy to
Change bridge

Trail reported that Mr M. O. McLainy to whom had been leased the ground under the bridge over Main street desired to remove some of the stay rods and braces in the structure to give him room to erect a building and replace them with arches or brackets. and that the same would in no wise affect the strength of the structure. Buck moved that the request be granted on condition that the said McLainy bear the expense of making the change seconded by McLainy and carried.

Buck offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: Whereas C. H. Bush member from the 3^d ward having been frequently guilty of conduct tending to bring this Council into disrepute by appearing in so drunken a condition as to cause his arrest and furthermore while so intoxicated is charged with unlawfully receiving handling and disposing of the poll books, tally sheets, tickets and other supplies and thereby greatly interfering with the lawful holding of an important election and the arrest for the same is such an offense against the reputation dignity and standing of this Council as to demand his withdrawal from this body.  Committee seconded by McLaney
 and carried.
