payment of bills

The finance Committee reported having approved a number of bills against the City and asked that they be read. The Clerk read the bills and Love moved that they be allowed as read and that an Ordinance be prepared providing for their payment. seconded by J.R. Williams and carried. The Ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Traut The Yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buesch Love Melaney Siefert Traut J.R. Williams, J.Y. Williams Kay and the Ordinance was declared passed.

bill of water Wks Co

Love of the finance Committee presented a bill in favor of the Alliance Water works Company for \$37 <sup>64</sup>/<sub>100</sub> for removing the water main in the railroad yards to allow the construction of a sewer by the railroad Company and the same was referred to the water Committee to report at next meeting.

present bill to Telephone Co

On motion of Love the Clerk was instructed to present a bill to the telephone Company for \$3<sup>00</sup> for the services of Ross Rue in superintending the setting of poles on South Liberty Street

Siefert of the Sewer Committee reported that some grading was necessary at the sewer disposal plant which was not provided for in the different contracts and suggested that this would be a good time to do the work and on motion

fire dept

A communication from the Chief of the fire Dept. asking that the present arrangement by which \$25<sup>00</sup> per month is allowed to employ three men to be on duty at the fire dept during the night be so changed as to allow the above amount for one regular man to be on duty at all times he agreeing to keep such man for that amount.

The Fire Committee submitted the following report: "We the undersigned members of the fire committee have carefully looked this matter up and find the above statement to be correct, and further recommend to the Council that the \$25<sup>00</sup> per month appropriated for the employment of three men to sleep at fire Dept headquarters that this \$25<sup>00</sup> to be paid to the employment of a regular man same to be placed on the pay roll of the city and to start from January 1<sup>st</sup> 1876"; signed.
