

Alliance O. Feby 3rd 1896

Council met in regular session with President Kay in the chair and the following members present. Buck Conger, Cornburgh Melaney Siefert Trail J. R. Williams J. Y. Williams Wilson Absent Bush Love.

Minutes of Jan'y 6th read and approved Trail of the finance committee reported having approved a number of bills against the City and asked that they be read. The bills were read and Conger moved that the bill of R. S. Kayles of \$220 for flag stone be not allowed and referred back to the Committee seconded by Trail and carried. Wilson then moved that the bills as read be allowed and that an Ordinance be prepared providing for their payment. seconded by Trail and carried. The Ordinance being prepared was read and Wilson moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas. Buck Conger Cornburgh Siefert Trail J. R. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 8 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

On motion of Conger the Street Commissioner was instructed to open a drain from Roseberry Street north to a pond of water north of D. Lloyd's property.

On Motion of Trail the street Commissioner was instructed to construct an alley crossing on Patterson Street.

On motion of Buck the Street Commissioner was instructed to remove some obstructions on Arch Street left there by the Street Railway Company.

A report of the Committee on unsafe buildings was submitted showing the work done by the Committee and calling attention to a vacancy on the board caused by Geo Middleton removing from the Corporation. and on motion of Wilson the report was adopted and on motion of Trail ~~the~~ Ross Rue was appointed to fill said vacancy.

On motion of Conger the Street Commissioner was instructed to repair the first alley crossing on the west side of Mechanic Street north of Main Street.

In the matter of the injunction obtained by Mrs Welch against the City and the Penn R R Co restraining the construction of a foot bridge from the overhead bridge on

On Main Street East to the Depot. Trail moved that the Solicitor be instructed to defend the City's interest in said action, seconded by Deferband Carried.

Duck moved that the ordinance to Establish a grade on Patterson Street be taken from the table (The same having been read 3^d time and tabled on March 18-1895) seconded by J.G. Williams and Carried. Duck then moved that the Ordinance be placed on its passage. seconded by Wilson. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Embaugh Wilson Trays Melaney Defer Trail J.R. Williams J.G. Williams Kay yeas 4 nays 6 and the motion was declared lost.

The matter of disposing of the Old Mt Union Cemetery was on motion of Wilson referred to the Cemetery Committee and Solicitor to report.

ordinance

An Ordinance to assess a special tax on the property abutting on the first alley south of and parallel with main street and lying between the public square and Linden Avenue was read first time and Wilson moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance be read second time by title, seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Embaugh Melaney Defer Trail J.R. Williams J.G. Williams Wilson Kay yeas 10 nays none. The rules were declared suspended. The Ordinance was read second time by title and Conger moved the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read third time by title, seconded by Trail. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Embaugh Melaney Trail Defer J.R. Williams J.G. Williams Wilson Kay yeas 10 nays 0.

The rules were declared suspended the Ordinance was read third time by title and Conger moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Fraile. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Cornbaugh Melaney Sefert Trail J.R. Williams J.G. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

An Ordinance to assess a special tax on the real estate bounding on South Webb Street from Ash street south to the first Alley south of and Parallel with Ash Street was read first time and Wilson moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance be read second time by title seconded by Conger. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Cornbaugh Melaney Trail Sefert J.R. Williams J.G. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 10 nays none. The rules were declared suspended the Ordinance was read second time by title and Conger moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read third time by title seconded by Sefert. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Cornbaugh Melaney Sefert Trail J.R. Williams J.G. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 10 nays none. The rules were declared suspended. The Ordinance was read third time by title and Wilson moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Fraile. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Buck Conger Cornbaugh Melaney Sefert Trail Melaney J.R. Williams J.G. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 10 nays none. and the Ordinance was declared passed.
