

Council Chamber Alliance O. Feb 24" 1896

Council met in special session upon the following call. "You are hereby notified that a special meeting of the Alliance City Council is called to meet on Monday evening February 24" 1896 at 7:30 P. M. to consider first. The matter of leasing public property second. - Legal matters connected with the Arch Street suit." B. F. Prescott, Mayor with President Kay in the chair and the following members present: Buck, Conger, Crumbaugh, Love, Melaney, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. G. Williams, Wilson. Absent Bush, DeFert.

Mr. F. H. Gaskill being present stated that if a satisfactory lease could be obtained for the west one hundred feet of the city lots he would endeavor to build on said ground an Opera house, and submitted a plan of same such as he contemplated building. Wilson moved that there be a committee of three appointed in connection with the solicitor to consider the matter and report at next meeting seconded by J. G. Williams and carried. Wilson moved that it be the sense of the Council that they cooperate with Mr. Gaskill in the enterprise along the line of the plan suggested. seconded by Buck and carried.

Love moved that the solicitor be authorized settle with the plaintiffs in the Arch Street injunction case on the terms that the city pay the costs on condition that the plaintiffs pay their assessments in full in accordance with the terms of the assessing Ordinance. seconded by Buck and Carried
