

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio March 9<sup>th</sup> 1896

Council met in adjourned session with President Key presiding and the following members present. Buck Crutbaugh Love Melaney Sept Trail J. R. Williams J. G. Williams Wilson. Absent Bush and Berger Minutes of Feb<sup>3<sup>d</sup></sup> 17-24 and March 2<sup>nd</sup> read and approved

Water mains in 6<sup>th</sup> ward

Professors Marsh and Kartsborn were present and requested that Council have the water mains extended in the 6<sup>th</sup> ward to give fire protection to the Mt Union College and on motion of Love the matter was referred to the Water Committee to report at next meeting.

Petition for Electric light

A Petition from residents of the third ward asking to have an electric light placed at the intersection of Garwood and South Liberty Streets was presented and on motion of J. G. Williams referred to the light Committee.

Finance Committee payment of bills

Love of the finance Committee reported a number of bills against the city and asked that they be read. The bills were read and Love moved that they be allowed as read and that an Ordinance be prepared providing for their payment seconded by Trail and carried. The Ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved it be placed on its passage seconded by J. R. Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Crutbaugh Love Melaney Sept Trail J. R. Williams J. G. Williams Wilson Key Yeas 10 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Bill of Canton bridge Co

Love presented a bill in favor of the Canton Bridge Company for \$410<sup>00</sup> for steps to the main street bridge and stated that in his opinion the County Commissioners should pay the claim. and on motion of Wilson the bill was referred to the finance Committee

Bill of Robert  
Auld

Mr Robert Auld presented a bill for services of volunteer firemen who assisted in putting out a fire at his barn during the last year and on motion of Wilson it was referred to the fire Committee.

Bill of Randolph

A bill in favor of W. K. Randolph for \$26<sup>72</sup> for lowering his sidewalk on Park Street was presented and on motion of Trail referred to the Street Committee.

South Liberty  
Street rebate

Leor of the finance Committee reported that there was yet remaining in the fund for the macadamizing of South Liberty Street the sum of \$245<sup>44</sup> which would allow a rebate of 10 cents per foot front and on motion of Sebert the report was accepted and the Committee instructed to ascertain to whom the money should be paid and report at next meeting.

Repair Catch  
basin

J. G. Williams reported the catch basin cover out of repair at the corner of Arch and Market streets and the street Commissioner was instructed to repair the same.

Repair Street  
Crossings

Trail reported some sidewalks and street crossings in the second ward needing repairs and they were referred to the Street Committee with power to act.

Mrs Webb's  
sidewalk

A petition signed by residents of North Webb Street asking that Council take the necessary steps to have a sidewalk laid in front of Mrs Jennie Webb's property was referred to the sidewalk Committee.

Steps to Main  
Street bridge

Trail called attention to the necessity of steps from the overhead bridge on the north side of the Railroad to lead to the Gordon property and on motion of Buck the same was referred to the Bridge Committee.

The ordinance was read second time by title and Buck moved that the rules be again suspended and the ordinance be read third time by title seconded by Wilson the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Embury Lovv Melaney Seferl Trail J. R. Williams J. G. Williams Wilson Kay Yeas 10 nays 0

The ordinance was read third time by title and Wilson moved its final passage seconded by Buck the yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Embury Lovv Melaney Trail Seferl J. R. Williams J. G. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 10 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.
