March 23rd 1896

Council met pursuant to the following call, "You are hereby notified that a special meeting of the Alliance City Council is called to meet on Monday evening March 23. 1896 at 7 o'clock to consider, 1st Clerks annual report, 2nd Leasing of city property, 3^d Legislation for lateral sewers, 4th Change of location of steps to Main Street bridge 5th Consideration and passing of ordinances and such other business as may properly come before Council"

A communication from A B Starr superintendent of the Penna R.R. Company stating that they desired to change the location of the proposed steps and foot bridge leading from the Main street bridge to the depot. from that shown on the plan adopted by building them on the north side of Main street instead of on the south side, and submitted a plan of the proposed change and Trail moved the same be approved seconded by Wilson and carried.

Conger moved that the bridge Committee be instructed to have risers put on the steps now built to the Main street bridge seconded by J. G. Williams and carried.

Dr Temple presented a petition from property owners on south Liberty Street asking that Council rebate them the money used in grading Liberty and Milner Streets near the south end of the south Liberty street improvement. the said grading having been paid for out of the money provided for the south Liberty street improvement and on motion of Love seconded by Buck the matter was referred to the solicitor to report.
