

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio April 13th 1896

Council met in regular session with President Kay presiding and the following members present: Buck, Conger, Cornbaugh, Love, Seft Trail, J. R. Williams, J. G. Williams, Wilson. Absent: Bush and Melaney. Minutes of meetings of March 9th and 23rd read and approved.

Claim of
Simeon Jennings

Mr J. D. Lewis Esq. addressed Council, stating that one Simeon Jennings had recently fallen off a bridge near the intersection of Walnut and North Freedom Streets and broken an arm and claimed that owing to the negligence of the city in not keeping the necessary guard rails on said bridge that he was entitled to damages and asked that Council pay him the sum of Three Hundred dollars and the doctor bill. and on motion of Wilson the matter was referred to the Judiciary Committee and Solicitor.

Payment of
Claims.

The Finance Committee reported having approved a number of bills against the city stating that they were in the hands of the Clerk and asked that they be read. The bills as approved were read and Love moved that they be allowed as read and that an Ordinance be prepared providing for their payment seconded by J. R. Williams and carried. The ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by J. R. Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas: Buck, Conger, Cornbaugh, Love, Seft Trail, J. R. Williams, J. G. Williams, Wilson, Kay. Yeas 10 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

The Clerk reported and read a ^{against the city} claim, filed April 11th 1896 by Fording & Harris in favor of C. L. Atkins in the sum of Three Thousand dollars ^{or} damages claimed by him ~~to~~ on account of the erection of the Main street bridge and on motion of Love seconded

by Trail the matter was referred to the Judiciary Committee and Solicitor.

Grading on
South Freedom

Mr Fryfoyle being present stated that some grading was necessary near his property on South Freedom Street and also some tile needed for a drain and said that he would do the work of grading and putting in the tile if the city would furnish them and allow him to have the surplus dirt and the same was on motion of Buck referred to the Street Committee and engineer.

Culvert at
Union Ave
bridges

Conger reported that the recent rains had again caused a washout on north Union Avenue near the railroad bridge and that it would be necessary to provide some method of taking care of the water at that point and moved that it be referred to the Sewer and Street Committees with power to act, seconded by Wilson. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Conger Crubaugh Love Siefert Trail J. R. Williams J. G. Williams Wilson Kay May Buck. Yeas 9 nays 1 and the motion was declared passed.

Repair Sewer
at Mechanic
Street

Conger reported that the wooden box sewer running east from Mechanic Street north of Main Street had fallen in in a number of places and would have to be repaired and moved that the same be referred to the Sewer and Street Committees with power to act, seconded by Trail. The yeas and nays were called resulting Yeas Buck Conger Crubaugh Love Siefert Trail J. R. Williams J. G. Williams Wilson Kay. Yeas 10 nays none. and the motion was declared carried.

Repair Culvert
on Park Street

Love reported that the arch culvert on Park Street had been damaged by the recent rains and was in danger of falling down. and on motion of Conger seconded by Trail the Clerk was instructed to notify Mr Robert Auld the contractor for said work to repair the same at once at his own expense and the Sewer Committee was instructed to see that it was attended to

Repair Vine
Street

Longer reported a washout on Vine Street near M Carley's and the street Commissioner was instructed to repair the same at once.

Repair Culvert
on South Arch

Buck reported that the Stone Culvert on South Arch street near the Carr Coal bank needed some repairs, and on motion of Wilson seconded by Inail the Clerk was instructed to notify the County Commissioners of the condition of it and ask the to make the necessary repairs.
