

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio May 25<sup>th</sup> 1896

Council met in regular session with President Kay presiding and the following members present: Comburgh, Love, Morgan Russell Scott Scranton Trail J.R. Williams absent. Sawyer. Defert. J.G. Williams

Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Tax levy

Love of the finance Committee reported an ordinance providing for the tax levy for the year 1896. such levy being for the general fund. 2 Mills Sinking fund 2 3 Mills Street fund .8 mills Salary 2 mills Light fund 1.2 mills Water 2. mills fire .9 mills Sewer 1. mill Bridge fund. .4 mills a total of 9 mills. Love moved the ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Comburgh. Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Scranton Trail, J.R. Williams Kay yeas 9 nays none. and the ordinance was declared passed.

special tax levy

An Ordinance to levy a special tax of one mill in addition to all other taxes for the purpose of pay floating debt bonds under authority of an act of the general assembly of the state of Ohio passed February 17<sup>th</sup> 1889. was read and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by Morgan the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Comburgh Love Morgan Russell Scott Scranton Trail J R Williams Kay yeas 9 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

maturing bonds

The Clerk reported that on June 15<sup>th</sup> Lateral sewer bonds to the amount of \$2000 would mature and on account of the assessments not being made there would be no funds to meet them and on motion of Russell the matter was referred to the finance Committee with power to act

C. C. Davidson asked for information concerning the repaving of Main street stating that the Street Railway Company intended relaying their track from Arch street to the Depot and if it was the intention for the city to pave the street they would desire the grade so that they might pave their portion in accordance with the same and on motion of <sup>Scranton</sup> Morgan the matter was referred to the Street Committee to report at next meeting.

Noble Street

Jno Matchett reported to Council that some work in the way of a culvert on Noble Street was necessary and on motion of Morgan the same was referred to the Street Committee to report at next meeting.

The grade committee to whom had been referred the claim of S. G. Well relative to the change of grade on Grant Street reported recommending that the matter be referred to the Finance and Judiciary Committees and on motion of Scranton the report was accepted.

On motion of Morgan the Clerk was instructed to correspond with the president of the Water Works Company and ask them to furnish water for the cemetery free of charge.
