

Alliance Ohio June 1st 1896

Regular session of Alliance City Council with president Kay presiding and the following members present. Conger Corubough. Love. Russell Scott Defert Trail. J. R. Williams J. G. Williams. absent Morgans and Scranton. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved

payment of bills.

Love of the finance committee reported that the committee had met and approved a number of bills against the city, stating that they were in the hands of the Clerk, and asked that they be read. The bills were read and Love moved that an ordinance be prepared providing for their payment seconded by Trail and carried. The ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved the same be placed on its passage seconded by J. R. Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger. Corubough Love Russell Scott Defert Trail J. R. Williams J. G. Williams Kay yeas 10 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Mayor's report

The Mayor's report of fines and licenses to the amount of \$90.00 collected during the month of May was read and on motion of Conger the same was accepted and ordered placed on file.

report on paving Main street

The Street committee to whom had been referred the matter of the paving of Main street reported that in their opinion it not be expedient to undertake to pave it this year.

Repair Noble Street

Defert moved that the Street committee be instructed to make the necessary repairs on Noble street referred to the committee at the preceding meeting, at a cost not to exceed \$15.00 seconded by Conger and carried.

notify Craven
to barricade

Russell moved that the Clerk be instructed to notify Mr J. C. Craven to erect a barricade to protect the alley along the west side of his property on Market street

Culvert on
Jersey Street

Trail reported that a culvert was needed on Jersey street and that if the city would furnish the tile the property owners in the vicinity would do the necessary work and on his motion the Street committee was instructed to furnish the necessary tile.

Sewer on
Chestnut Street

Scott reported that there was an open ditch on west Chestnut street in the 6th ward, which should be tiled and moved that the matter be referred to the street committee to report at next meeting.

On motion of J. G. Williams the Clerk was instructed to notify the Penna R.R. Co to place a hand railing on the bridge on north Walnut street

Street Cleaning
Contract

A contract with O. Shidler for cleaning the streets was on motion of Conger referred to the street committee to report at next meeting.

Committee to go
to New York

Conger moved that there be appointed a committee of two consisting of the Chairman of the finance committee and the City Clerk to go to New York City and confer with Mr Rumble relative to the purchase of the Water works by the City, and secure all information possible to present to Council concerning the works seconded by J. R. Williams and carried.

Conger then moved that Mr May president of Council be added to the committee seconded by Trail and carried.

Conger moved that there be appropriated the sum of \$150⁰⁰ for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said committee seconded by Trail and carried.

Russell reported that the basins and surroundings around the Water Works were not kept
