Love moved that the street committee be instructed to have a plank crossing constructed across Warehouse street in the rear of John Shurer's property seconded by Trail and carried.

Clean up
streets

Russell reported that many of the streets in the city were in bad condition owing to the accumulation of stones, brick, boards &c and moved that the street committee be instructed to have the street Commissioner clean them up. seconded by Conger and carried.

Slown's alley

Love reported that Mr James Slown had made complaint that an alley adjoining his property in the first ward had been closed up and the same was referred to the platting committee.

 to comply with such request was read and ordered
 placed on file

The report of the committee
 appointed to confer with Mr Runkle relative to the
 purchase of the water works was submitted and
 an motion of Trail ordered placed on file
