

Council Chamber Alliance Ohio June 22nd 1896

Council met in regular session with president May in the chair and the following members present: Love, Morgan, Russell, Scranton, Defert, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. Y. Williams, absent Conyer, Orubaugh and Scott. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Defert reported that a culvert on Summit Street between Linden and Arch was in bad condition and suggested that a tile culvert be built. And on motion of Trail seconded by Scranton the same was referred to the Street Committee with power to act.

Morgan reported the necessity of an alley crossing on Summit Street between Webb and Morgan streets and the same was referred to the Street Committee.

Love reported that some grading was necessary on Columbia Street, referred to the Street Committee to report at next meeting.

Morgan reported that Summit Street east of Morgan Street was in bad condition and the same was referred to the Street Committee to report at next meeting.

A petition signed by residents of South Seneca Street asking that said street be graded from Grant to Wilbur without cost to the property owners was presented and on motion of J. Y. Williams referred to the Street Committee and Engineer to report at next meeting.

J. Y. Williams reported that owing to the condition of the grade on Park Street south of Main Street the water run over on the sidewalks and moved. The matter be referred to the Street Committee to investigate and report at next meeting seconded by Scranton and Carried.

J. Y. Williams reported that Grant Street near Union Avenue was in bad condition, referred to Street Committee to report at next meeting.

Love reported that the sewer disposal works were now about completed and that it would be necessary to select some one to take charge of the same and moved that a special committee of three be appointed to consider the applications now on file for the position and report recommendations to Council at next meeting seconded by Scranton. Trail moved to amend by substituting the sewer committee for special committee seconded by Russell and carried, as was also the original motion as amended.

Scranton moved that the question of taking care of the water at the Union Avenue bridge be referred to the Engineer to submit a plan for same seconded by Trail and carried.

On motion of Trail the Clerk was instructed to advertise for bids for furnishing coal for the sewer disposal works.

A resolution requiring the owner of the east half of out lot no 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ (Mrs Bleakley) to construct a sidewalk in front of said lot was read and Russell moved its adoption seconded by Defert. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Love Morgan Russell Scranton Defert Trail J. R. Williams J. Y. Williams Kay yeas 9 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

A resolution requiring M. Earley Trustee of the Lamborn Estate to construct a sidewalk in front of the west half of out lot no 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ was offered and Russell moved its adoption seconded by J. R. Williams. The yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Love Morgan Russell Scranton Defert Trail J. R. Williams J. Y. Williams Kay yeas 9 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

J. Y. Williams reported that certain parties had constructed steps to the building at the corner of Grant and Arch streets and that said steps were so built as to occupy a portion of the

sidewalk and moved the matter be referred to the sidewalk committee to report at next meeting. seconded by Trill and carried.

J. G. Williams reported the wooden culvert on Grant Street east of Union Avenue in bad condition and the same was referred to the sidewalk committee and Solicitor with instructions to ascertain and report whose duty it is to repair that part covered by the sidewalk.

Russell called attention to the case of the city against John Loftis for violation of prohibitory ordinance which case had been brought several years ago and carried to the supreme court and judgment recently rendered in favor of the city. F. Moore and Jas. Kelley being on Mr. Loftis' bond for the payment of the amount. and moved that the matter be referred to the judiciary committee with power to settle the claim upon the said defendants paying all costs incurred by the city in prosecuting said case, and all court charges, seconded by Sept. ~~and approved charges~~ amended by referring to the Judiciary Committee and Solicitor to report at next meeting seconded and carried. The original motion as amended was then put and carried thereupon Council adjourned.
