City Council met in regular session with Vice President Love in chair and the following members present Love, Conger, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Sefert, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. Y. Williams, Kay. Absent Crubaugh. Minutes of preceding meeting read and approved.

Mayor's Report.

The Mayor's report of Taxes and Licenses to the amount of One hundred & $\frac{50}{100}$ Dollars collected during the month of June was read and on motion of Conger and seconded by Trail the report was accepted and placed on file.

Payment of Bills.

Trail of the Finance Committee reported the Finance committee had met and approved a number of Bills against the City and that the same were in the hands of the Clerk and asked that they be read, the Bills were read and Trail moved that an Ordinance be prepared providing for their payment seconded by Russell and carried. The Ordinance being prepared was read and Trail moved the same be placed on its passage, seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Sefert, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. Y. Williams yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Bills referred back

Trail reported a number of Bills not approved by Finance committee and Conger moved they be referred back to the Finance and Fire committees seconded by Trail and carried.

On motion of Trail seconded by J. Y. Williams the Wm August Bill for \$10. $\frac{39}{100}$ that had been approved by the Finance committee was referred back to the Finance and Fire committees.

J. Y. Williams moved that the Gyger Bill for \$12. $\frac{50}{100}$ be accepted seconded by Conger and carried.

Bids to furnish coal.
at Sewer disposal.

The Bids to furnish coal for one year at the Sewer Disposal works was read and W. W. Gilson's bid was \$4.22 per ton for run of the mine, it being the lowest Conger moved it be accepted seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Sefert, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. Y. Williams, Kay yeas 11 nays none.

By Engineers to have charge of Sewer disposal works

Conger moved that the City Engineer have full charge of Sewer disposal works and be responsible for same. J. Y. Williams moved the above motion be laid on

the table for one week seconded by Trail and lost.
 Trail ^{moved to} amended the original motion by giving the
 Engineer full charge of the Disposal works except the
 hiring of help and buying of material the amendment
 was lost.

The original motion was then put and carried.
 On motion of Morgan the Clerk was instructed to notify
 all persons having their sanitary sewerage connected
 with storm water sewers disconnected at once and connect
 with the sanitary sewer. seconded by Conger and carried.
 Morgan moved that a grade for sidewalks be given on
 Columbia street between Seneca and Liberty Streets seconded
 by J. R. Williams and carried.

An Ordinance to regulate the use of Bicycles, Tricycles
 and Tandems in the streets and sidewalks of the City
 of Alliance Ohio was read and on motion of Morgan
 seconded by Conger the ordinance was laid on the
 table for one week.

Russell reported that Mr Cantine had offered to furnish
 tar to the City free of charge to put on the Bridge to
 preserve the plank and on motion of Russell seconded
 by Trail the matter was referred to the Bridge committee.

On motion Council adjourned.
