

Alliance Ohio August 3rd 1896.

City Council met in regular session with President Kay presiding and the following members present, Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, J. G. Williams absent Sefert and J. R. Williams

Minutes of meetings of July 20 and July 25 read and approved.

Report of the Secy of the Cemetery Directors.

J. K. Allen Secy of the Alliance Cemetery Board submitted the following report for the Quarter ending June 30 1896.

On motion of Conger seconded by Trail the above report was accepted and placed on file.

Mayors Report.

The Mayors report for the month of July showing Fines and Licenses collected to the amount of \$70.³²/₁₀₀ was accepted and placed on file.

Payment of Bills.

Love of the Finance Committee reported that a number of Bills had been approved and asked that they be read, the Bills were read, Love called the Councils attention to the fact of there not being sufficient money in the General and Street funds to pay the claims and moved that there be transferred from the unappropriated fund to the General \$25.00 and to the Street fund \$25.00 see by Trail an carried.

Love moved that an Ordinance be prepared for the payment of Claims seconded by Trail and carried The Ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved it be placed on its passage seconded by Trail the yeas and Nays were called resulting yeas, Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, J. G. Williams, Kay yeas 10 Nays none the Ordinance was declared passed.

Union Ave Sewer.

John G. Williams moved that the sewer Com be instructed to proceed with the Union Ave sewer according to the plans of the City Engineer seconded by Conger the yeas and Nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, J. G. Williams, Kay Nays Crubaugh yeas 9 Nays 1 the motion passed.

Awarding contracts
for Lateral Sewers.

On motion of J. G. Williams seconded by Conger the Street Commissioner was instructed to open the ditches on Mechanic St north of Main St.

Love stated that Duffey and Piro were the lowest bidders for constructing Lateral Sewers No 16-17-18 and moved they be awarded the contract for building the same seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, J. G. Williams, Kay yeas 10 Nays none and the contract was declared awarded.

Love moved that W. McAuley be awarded the contract for constructing Lateral Sewers No 24 and 25 he being the lowest bidder seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, J. G. Williams, Kay yeas 10 Nays none the contract was declared awarded.

Robert Auld being the lowest bidder on Lateral sewer No 21 Love moved that he be awarded the contract seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, J. G. Williams, Kay yeas 10 Nays none the contract was awarded Robert Auld.

On motion of Love seconded by Seranton the Mayor was authorized to sign contracts with the different Contractors as soon as the money was in the Treasury to the credit of the proper fund and the Contractors be permitted to commence work at once.

Love moved that the contract for the Plumbing in the City Prison and Closet out side be awarded to Ellis & McDonald seconded by J. G. Williams and carried.

On motion of Love seconded by Conger John Filson was employed by the City to work at the Sewer Disposal Works for two months at \$1.25 per day, 10 hours each day.

On Motion of J. G. Williams seconded by Seranton the City Engineer was instructed to give and estimate of the cost of laying a Flag stone walk at the corner of Union Ave and Grant St and report at next meeting.

Morgan reported a sidewalk on Oxford St between Seneca and Freedom Avenues in bad condition and moved the matter be referred to the Sidewalk Com with power to act seconded by Conger and carried.

On motion of Seranton seconded by J. G. Williams the City Engineer was instructed to give the proper
