

Alliance Chur August 31st 1886.

City Council met in regular session with Vice President Loe in the chair and the following members present Conger, Crubaugh, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. G. Williams.

Minutes of the preceding ^{meeting} read and approved.

The resignation of Rev F. W. Corl as a member of the Board of Health from the fifth ward was submitted and on motion of J. G. Williams seconded by Trail the same was accepted.

Loe of the Finance Committee reported a Bill due the W. H. H. Peck Co of \$425.00 for Fire Hoses. J. G. Williams moved that an Ordinance be prepared for the payment of the Bill seconded by Morgan and Carried.

The Ordinance being prepared was read and J. G. Williams moved the same be placed on its final passage seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Crubaugh, Loe, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. G. Williams Yeas 10 Nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Mr T. P. Marsh and Mr R. Fording addressed the Council in regard to location for a water plug near the College in the Sixth ward and also asked permission to grade some of the streets near the College without any expense to the City in order to get the dirt to make some necessary fill on the College grounds.

J. G. Williams moved that the Directors of the College be granted permission to grade certain streets near the College seconded by Conger and carried.

On motion of Trail seconded by Russell the matter of locating a Hydrant in the sixth ward near the College was referred to the Water Committee.

On motion of Morgan seconded by J. R. Williams the grading of the streets near the College in the sixth ward was to be done under the instructions of the City Engineer.

Morgan moved that the matter of Sanitary sewer back of the Wybrecht Block be referred to the Sewer Committee seconded by Trail and carried.

S. W. Seacrist addressed the Council and asked them to take some action in regard to running a Sanitary sewer in the Alley back of his premises and on motion of

Seranton seconded by J. R. Williams the matter was referred to the Sewer Committee.

Trail called the Council's attention to a sewer connection that had been made on Patterson St being left in bad condition and moved that the City Engineer look after the matter seconded by J. G. Williams and carried.

Sidewalk Resolutions

The following resolution was offered: Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, that it is necessary, and that a sidewalk 6 feet wide, and of Flag stone or Brick shall be constructed along the east end of out lot No 137 to the established grade, and in accordance with the ordinances of this City. And the Mayor is hereby instructed to cause written notice to be served upon the owner of said premises of the passage of this resolution. Russell moved the adoption of the above resolution seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. G. Williams yeas 10 Nays none the resolution was declared adopted.

The following resolution was offered: Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, that it is necessary, and that a sidewalk 6 feet wide, and of Flag stone or Brick shall be constructed along the north ends of Lots No 643 and 644 to the established grade, and in accordance with the ordinances of this City. And the Mayor is hereby instructed to cause written notice to be served upon the owner of said premises of the passage of this resolution. Russell moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by J. G. Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. G. Williams yeas 10 Nays none the resolution was declared adopted.

Russell offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, that it is necessary, and that a sidewalk 6 feet wide, and of Flag stone or Brick shall be constructed along the west end of lot No 189 to the established grade, and in accordance with the ordinances of this City. And the Mayor is hereby instructed to cause written notice to be served upon the owner of said premises of the passage of this resolution. Conger seconded the motion to adopt the above resolution the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Seranton,

Trail, J. R. Williams, J. Y. Williams yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

On motion of Russell seconded by J. Y. Williams the St Commissioner was instructed to make a Cinder walk along the City lot at the corner of Columbia and Mechanic Streets.

Trail reported a sidewalk on Franklin Ave in bad condition and move the matter be referred to the sidewalk committee seconded by J. Y. Williams & Carnie

On motion of Scranton seconded by J. R. Williams the Engineer was instructed to give Mr Smith the grade for a sidewalk in front of his property on Park Ave.

The following resolution was offered. Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, that the present Street Railway track between Arch Avenue and the east terminus thereof is a nuisance and dangerous.

That said Street Railway has not complied with its Charter in this that it has allowed its Railway to become out of repair and dangerous: that the City Clerk be instructed to notify the proper officer or employer of said Street Railway to put its tracks in proper and safe condition by Sept 3rd 1896 and unless it is so repaired that the Street Commissioner is hereby directed to remove said track at once between the points named. Conger moved the adoption of the above resolution seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Crubaugh, Loe, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. Y. Williams Nays Scranton yeas 9 nays 1 the resolution was declared adopted.

An Ordinance to establish the grade of High St between Union Avenue and the Lake Erie Alliance and Southern Rail Road was read first time and J. Y. Williams moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance be read second time by Title seconded by Morgan the yeas and nays were called resulting Conger, Crubaugh, Loe, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, J. R. Williams, J. Y. Williams yeas 10 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read second time by Title. Scranton moved the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance read third time by title seconded by J. R. Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting
