

— Alliance Ohio October 19th 1896.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session with President Kay in the chair and the following members present Crubaugh, Love, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail J. R. Williams, J. Y. Williams.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved.

Communication
from Mr. Hebert.

A. Communication from Mr. Hebert was read asking the Council to place a light at the corner of Union Ave and Vine Streets and also calling their attention to the condition of North Union Ave and East Vine St. On motion the matter was referred to the Light and Street Committee.

Petition to move
light in 6th ward.

A. Petition signed by a number of Citizens on South Union Ave in the Sixth ward was read, asking the Council to move the light now located opposite the Old Cemetery north to the intersection of Mill St and Union Ave. On motion of Scott the matter was referred to the Light Com to report at next meeting.

Coal Bids

Bids to furnish the City Hall with Coal for the ensuing year was read as follows W. A. Taylor \$2.00 Per Ton, E. S. Davis \$1.85 Per Ton J. H. Well \$1.85 Per Ton There being two bids the same. Love moved that all bids be rejected seconded by Crubaugh and carried.

On motion of Love seconded by J. R. Williams the Clerk was instructed to notify all coal dealers to hand in new bids.

St drain on
Broadway

Love moved that the matter of placing a street drain on Broadway in proper condition be referred to the street committee with power to act seconded by J. R. Williams and carried.

G. B. W. Coates matter

Russell reported that the St Committee had investigated the G. B. W. Coates matter on Ely St and found that he had been charged for 17 ft of St impairment to much and moved that the amount be deducted from his St assessment seconded by J. R. Williams and lost.

Scranton moved that the St Commissioner be instructed to haul some Cinders for a crossing on Oxford St near the Bridge see by Trail and Lost.

On motion of Love seconded by Trail the matter of heating the building at the Sewage Disposal Works was referred to the Sewer Committee.

J. G. Williams moved that the St Commissioner be instructed to place a plank trunk across the walk at the Prof Morris property on South Freedom St seconded by Seranton and carried.

J. G. Williams moved that the City Council meet on the first and third Monday nights of each month at 7 O'clock from now until the first of April 1897 seconded by Trail and carried.

On motion Council adjourned.
