Mayors Report

The Mayors report for the month of October showing fines and licenses collected to the amount of \$24,35⁰⁰/₁₀₀ was read. On Motion of Love the report was accepted and placed on file.

Bids to furnish
Coal for City Hall.

Bids to furnish the City Hall with coal for the ensuing year was read as follows Jno Cull & Sons \$1.80 Per Ton, J. G. Tolbert & Son \$1.79 Per Ton, J. H. Mell \$1.79 Per Ton, E. S. Davis \$1.78 Per Ton, R. J. E. Hagen \$1.75 Per Ton.

Love moved that the Bid of R. J. E. Hagen be accepted and he be required to give a bond of \$200⁰⁰ See by Scott & carried.

Payment of Claims

Love reported that the Finance Committee had met and approved a number of Bills against the City and asked the Clerk to read the same the Bills were read and Love stated that there was not sufficient money in the General fund to pay the claims and moved that there be transferred from the unapportioned fund to the General fund \$39.00 seconded by Trail and carried.

Love moved that an Ordinance be prepared for the payment of the claims. the Ordinance being prepared was read and Love moved it be placed on its passage seconded by Seranton the yeas and Nays were called resulting yeas Curlough, Love, Scott, Seranton, Seft, Trail, Kay yeas 7 Nays none, the Ordinance was declared passed.

Love moved that the Central Union Telephone Co be allowed to take the Telephone now located in the 6th ward and place the same at the Fire Department and take the one now located at the Fire Department and put it in the Sewage Disposal Building seconded by Trail & carried.
