

Alliance Ohio Nov 16th 1896.

Alliance City Council met in regular session with president Kay presiding and the following members present. Crubaugh, Love, Scott, Seranton, Trail, J. R. Williams J. G. Williams.

Minutes of the two preceding meetings read and approved.

Cemetery Report.

J. K. Allen Secretary of the Alliance Cemetery Directors submitted the following report for the Quarter ending September 30-1896.

On motion of J. R. Williams the report was accepted and placed on file.

Petition from Second Ward

A. Petition signed by about 125 Citizens from the second ward asking the Council to place an arc light on the north end of the east Main St Bridge was read and on motion of Seranton seconded by J. G. Williams the matter was referred to the Light Committee.

Prohibition Alley

E. H. Brosius and B. F. Mercer addressed the Council and called their attention to the bad condition of Prohibition Alley, on motion of Trail seconded by Scott the matter was referred to the Committee on Street and Alley and City Engineer with power to act. the above named committee was to see that all Sanitary sewerage running into said Alley be cut off at once.

Grading the Alley north of & west of Freedom St to the M. E. Church.

Seranton moved that the first Alley north of Broadway & west of Freedom St be graded so as to keep the water from damaging the M. E. Church walls the work to be done under the supervision of the Street Committee and City Engineer seconded by Scott and carried.

Mr. Edwards sidewalk.

Mr. Wm Edwards addressed the Council and stated that he was ready to put a sidewalk down along his property at the corner of Broadway and South Webb St as soon as the City would grade South Webb St.

On motion of Love the Street Commissioner was instructed to cut a ditch along South Webb St to keep the water off Mr Edwards walk just as soon as he layed his walk down.

On motion of Lorr seconded by Trail the City Engineer was authorized to issue permits to make connections with Lateral sewers No 17-18-21-24-25.

Lorr moved that the matter of heating the Sewage Disposal Works be left in the hands of the City Engineer seconded by J. R. Williams and carried.

On motion of Lorr seconded by Trail Ruffy & Piers was given an extension of 30 days time to complete Lateral Sewer No 16.

Lorr moved that the grade on Prospect Street be referred to the Committee on grades seconded by Seranton and carried.

The Light Committee submitted the following report.

We the undersigned members of the Light Committee to whom was referred the matter of placing a light at the intersection of Union Ave and Pine St. after a thorough investigation find that owing to lack of funds the City is unable at the present time to increase the number of lights. And in regard to changing the light now located on South Union Ave opposite the old Cemetery, report favorable to moving the same north to the intersection of Mill street and Union^{Ave} at a cost not to exceed five dollars
