

Alliance Ohio March 15<sup>th</sup> 1897

City Council met in regular session with president Kay in the Chair and the following members present, Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved.

Appropriation ordered to defray expenses in Shins case

On motion of Trail seconded by Conger there was an appropriation of fifty dollars made to defray expenses in the E. L. Shins case.

Conger moved that the City Solicitor be authorized to employ Judge Day to assist him in the Shins case seconded by Trail and lost.

Com to assist in getting testimony in Shins & Jennings case

On motion of Russell seconded by Love the President was instructed to appoint a committee to assist the Solicitor in looking up testimony in the Shins and Jennings cases against the City, the President appointed to serve on the above mentioned committee Mr Russell and Mr Love.

Change voting place in third ward

On motion of Conger seconded by Scott the voting place in the third ward was ordered changed from the Stillwell room to the Colestock room on High street between Sencee and Liberty streets.

Resolution to issue Cemetery Bonds

The following resolution was presented and read declaring it necessary to issue Bonds for erecting a Vault and embellishing the Cemetery grounds.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio that it is necessary to issue and sell Bonds of said City in the sum of three thousand dollars for the purpose of erecting a Vault on and embellishing the grounds of the Cemetery of said City known as the Alliance Cemetery and the question of issuing and selling said Bonds in the amount aforesaid be submitted to the electors of said City at the general election to be held in said City on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of April 1897.

And the Mayor of said City is hereby directed to give notice of the holding of such election and the submission of said question in the manner provided by law, and the Mayor is further directed to send a certified copy of this resolution to the deputy supervisors of elections of Stark County, Ohio. Scranton moved the above resolution be adopted see by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Crubaugh, Love, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail Kay yeas & nays none the resolution was declared adopted.
