

Alliance Ohio April 12th 1897.

City Council met in regular session with president Kay presiding and the following members present, Congr Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, J. R. Williams.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved. The Clerk reported that in compliance with the Law he called the mayor to his assistance and canvassed the votes cast at the Municipal election held on April 5th 1897 and announced the names of the Officers elected as follows. Councilman in the first O. C. Conger, second ward Frank J. Miller, third ward J. R. Williams, fourth ward A. B. Love, fifth ward G. G. King, sixth ward Thomas Wilson.

Assessor in the first ward Emory Osborne, second ward R. E. Morgan, third ward A. L. Hubbard, fourth ward James M. Gregor, fifth ward Harper Brosius, sixth ward W. B. Crubaugh. Cemetery Director Ira T. Tullis. on motion of Love the report was accepted and placed on file.

Mayors Report for the month of March was read showing fines and licenses collected to the amount of Three & ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars, the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The resignation of W. B. Crubaugh as member of Council from the sixth ward was read and on motion of Trail seconded by Congr the resignation was accepted.

J. K. Allen secretary of the Alliance Cemetery Directors submitted the following report for quarter ending Mar 31/97.

Trail moved that the resolution be adopted seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Love, Russell, Morgan, Scott, Seranton, Trail, J. R. Williams, Kay yeas 9 nays none, the resolution was declared adopted.

Resolution instructing Civil Engineer to use laborer at Disposal work as assistant.

The following resolution was offered by Love. Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio, That the City Engineer be instructed to use the laborer at the Sewage Disposal works as an assistant at such times as he may need him. Conger moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Seranton the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Love, Morgan, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, J. R. Williams, Kay yeas 9 nays none, the resolution was declared adopted.

Shims case to be taken to higher Court.

On motion of Trail seconded by Seranton the City Solicitor was instructed to carry the C. L. Shims case against the city to a higher Court.

On motion Council adjourned.
