The City Engineer presented his report as to the condition of the sewer on Seneca Avenue south of Oxford street, and stated that the trouble at that point could be remedied by closing the Catch Basins at the ~~intersection of~~ Oxford and Seneca and Summit and Seneca at a probable cost of ten dollars.

Love moved that the two Catch Basins spoken of by the Engineer be ordered closed seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas. Conger, Kay, King, Love, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Wilson. yeas 10 nays none the Catch Basins were ordered closed.

Wilson called the Councils attention to the necessity of sidewalks along the west side of Arch street between Millner street and State street and moved that the same be referred to the sidewalk Committee to make a report on the matter seconded by Seranton & carried. On motion of Trail Council adjourned.
